Ball State (+2) upset Akron 42-28. However, Akron had a 419-374 yard edge. The Zips were stopped on downs three times in Ball State territory and allowed a 90-yard kick return TD.

Missouri (-1.5) beat Auburn 23-17 in double overtime. Auburn had a 357-343 yard edge and missed three field goals.

BYU (+4.5) upset Utah 24-21. Utah had a 470-368 yard edge but were stopped on downs three times deep in BYU territory.

Texas (-12) beat Kentucky 16-13 in overtime. However, Kentucky had a 395-179 yard edge.

Alabama (-9.5) beat Tennessee 37-20. However, Tennessee had a 410-373 yard edge. Alabama got a 99-yard interception return TD on the final play of the first half. Tennessee also got stopped on downs at the Alabama 16-yard line and finished the game on the Alabama 1-yard line.

Stanford (+17.5) upset Florida State 20-13. However, Florida State had a commanding 444-293 yard edge. They got stopped at the one-foot line on the game's final play and committed a penalty on a missed FG that led to a Stanford TD.

Bad Beats

Notre Dame (-10.5) beat USC 34-24. The number mattered in this game as ND was bet up from -8.5 during the week. ND missed an extra point after their final TD.

The total in the Tennessee/Alabama game was 61. It appeared Tennessee scored a TD on the final play of the game that would have put the game over the total but they did not review the play.

Georgia (-7.5) beat Ole Miss 43-35. Georgia trailed 35-26 entering the 4Q. UGA kicked a FG with 2:06 left to go up 8 and it was the only time they were covering during the game.

The total in the Memphis/UAB game was 59.5. Trailing 31-24, Memphis got to the UAB 1-yard line in the final minute but couldn't score.

-Florida fired head coach Billy Napier. Florida is 3-4 this year and Napier has gone 22-23 there in four years. WR's coach Bill Gonzales will be interim.

-Colorado State fired head coach Jay Norvell. Colorado State is 2-5 this year and Norvell has gone 18-26 there in four years. DC Tyson Summers will be interim.

-Texas safety Michael Taaffe underwent thumb surgery on Monday. It is not expected to be season ending.

-Clemson leading receiver Bryant Wesco will miss the rest of the season after a scary flip on a punt return that required a trip to the hospital.

-Purdue QB Ryan Browne is doubtful for the Rutgers game.

-Auburn starting center Connor Lew is out for the season (ACL).

-Drew Pyne (leg) has missed the last two games and is questionable this week.

-Kansas State DE Tobi Osunsanmi is out for the season.

-Memphis QB Brendon Lewis (leg) is questionable this week.

-Stanford QB Ben Gulbranson (leg) is questionable this week.

Games in Rotation Order

Wednesday, October 22nd

DELAWARE 30 Middle Tennessee 21. Both need a win. Middle has lost 3 straight while Delaware has dropped back-to-back games outright as a favorite. Our power ratings like the Blue Hens here but we prefer UNDER as MT has only averaged 17 ppg on offense this year.

Missouri State 25 NEW MEXICO STATE 24. New Mexico State has been better in the stats with a -0.3 ypp margin while Missouri State is -0.6. Missouri State has played the much tougher schedule though (No. 84 vs No. 155). True frosh QB Deuce Bailey might be making another start here for Missouri State. We lean UNDER.

Thursday, October 23rd

South Alabama 30 GEORGIA STATE 24. Both teams have fallen on hard times. Despite losers of 6 straight, South Alabama is only -0.2 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, Georgia State is -1.2 in ypp margin (No. 125). Georgia State is 1-6 ATS failing to cover their games by an average of 11.8 ppg. We lean UNDER.

Friday, October 24th

North Texas 41 CHARLOTTE 17. Charlotte is arguably the most banged up team in the country and the results reflect that as they are No. 130 in ypp margin, No. 131 in ypg margin and No. 131 in scoring margin. Meanwhile, North Texas boasts the No. 1 scoring offense averaging 45 ppg. With that being said, our power ratings do like Charlotte here. We lean dog and UNDER.

VIRGINIA TECH 25 California 23. Cal is coming off a fortunate win over North Carolina last Friday as the Tar Heels had a late fumble at the goal line. They're taking on a Hokies team off a bye but just playing out the season with an interim. Cal has the better ypp margin (-0.2 vs -0.6) and has more to play for. We bet them +4.5.

Boise State 37 NEVADA 16. Very quietly, Boise State has ripped off SIX straight covers since the opening upset loss at USF. They knocked off unbeaten UNLV last week as they outscored the Rebels 28-7 in the second half. Nevada is just 1-6 on the season but have 3 more losses by a TD or less after suffering six of those last year. We don't expect this one to be close. Lean OVER.

Saturday, October 25th

Connecticut 30 RICE 20. UConn took a lot of money in the market last week and flipped from dog to favorite vs BC. That money proved correct as they won 38-23. Their only two losses this year came in OT after blown leads in the 4th quarter. They're taking on a Rice team off a bye. We're close to the number here.

BUFFALO 30 Akron 20. Buffalo had another close call vs a MAC bottom feeder last week. The Bulls trailed UMass 14-3. Akron got bet to a road favorite vs Ball State but lost by 14 despite a 419-374 yard edge. Our ratings are close to the number here.

CINCINNATI 33 Baylor 30. Cincy has been impressive with six straight wins. The Bearcats rank No. 6 with a +2.3 ypp margin. Their offense ranks No. 2 averaging 7.7 yards per play. Baylor has been involved in four games decided by six points or less already. We expect another photo finish. Our ratings like Baylor and UNDER.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN 31 Massachusetts 15. UMass played arguably their best game of the season last week but blew a double-digit lead vs Buffalo. The Minutemen rank dead last in scoring margin at -24.3 points per game. They're taking on a CMU off one of their best performances, a 27-6 upset win at Bowling Green. However, we're not wild laying 3 scores with an offense that averages 22.6 ppg and a CMU team that plays the third slowest tempo.

Tcu 35 WEST VIRGINIA 20. Since upsetting Pitt, West Virginia has lost its last four games by an average of 43-15 while getting outgained by 211 ypg. They're banged up and non-competitive. TCU head coach Sonny Dykes is not the most trust-worthy commodity as a road favorite. We didn't bet side or total.

GEORGIA TECH 35 Syracuse 17. Georgia Tech had a misleading win over Duke as they got a 95-yard fumble return TD. The unbeaten Yellow Jackets were actually 3.5-point underdogs in the game. Despite a No. 7 AP Poll ranking, we have them No. 28 in our power ratings. They should have no problem though with a Syracuse team that lost their offense with the injury to QB Angeli. They've lost 3 straight with Collins at QB averaging just 11 ppg. We lean UNDER.

INDIANA 40 UCLA 16. UCLA has won three straight under interim Tim Skipper and OC Jerry Neuheisel. However, they're facing an Indiana team that ranks No. 1 in the country with a +32.3 scoring margin per game. Curt Cignetti's press conference early this week indicated to us that the Hoosiers are taking this game seriously. That's not good news for the Bruins. We lean OVER.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

LOUISVILLE 40 Boston College 17. The market bet Louisville like they knew the final score and the Cardinals played by far their best game of the season in the upset of Miami. Will we see some consistency now from Louisville who will be favored in their remaining six games? What we have consistently seen is Boston College get worse by the week. They've now lost six straight. We lean OVER.

MIAMI, FL 38 Stanford 10. Miami suffered their first loss of the season last week. QB Carson Beck had a nightmare game with four interceptions and Mario Cristobal got out-coached by Jeff Brohm to no surprise. They're facing a Stanford team fresh off a huge upset of Florida State. However, they lost their starting QB Gulbranson to injury (? here). How motivated is Miami to get big margin?

Michigan 30 MICHIGAN STATE 17. MSU dominated this series from 2008-2017 with 10 straight covers but Michigan has won the last 3 by a combined 102-24. The Wolverines are off their best performance of the season in a must-win over Washington. Michigan State QB Chiles had a good game (27 of 33) vs Indiana but it wasn't enough. Anytime there's a big rivalry, we gravitate toward the big home underdog and that's the case here.

Virginia 31 NORTH CAROLINA 21. North Carolina played their best game of the season last week. They nearly pulled the upset over Cal but fumbled crossing the goal line late in the game. UVA survived a possible major upset from Washington State. NC's No. 133 offense will have to keep pace with a UVA offense that averages 40 ppg. However, we're sure if we trust UVA laying more than 10 on the road.

Pittsburgh 31 NC STATE 25. Pitt has easily won and covered three straight with true frosh QB Heintschel. Their offense is averaging 38.4 ppg (No. 13) and our ratings say they are the play here. The problem is we like the spot here for NC State coming off a bye. Pitt HC Narduzzi is notoriously inconsistent and we bet the Wolf Pack here (you need a +7 or better though price wise).

Rutgers 29 PURDUE 28. Rutgers defense allowed 750 yards last week to Oregon. That's not a typo...SEVEN-HUNDRED AND FIFTY YARDS! The Scarlet Knights now rank dead last allowing 7.8 yards per play and are dead last in ypp margin at -2.2. Purdue's offense was a complete failure last week getting shutout at Northwestern. QB Browne is doubtful here. Lean Purdue but need a "+3".

Smu 30 WAKE FOREST 24. SMU is coming off their best performance of the season as they upset Clemson. The Tigers were playing with a backup QB but SMU's offense put up 429 yards and the defense limited Clemson to just 35 yards rushing. They're facing a dangerous Wake team off a bye. The Demon Deacons have been much better than expected this year with a +2.1 ypp margin (No. 9 in the country). Their defense is allowing just 4.2 ypp (No. 8). Just before press-time a prominent service gave out Wake +3.5. They seem to be the sharper side this week. Our ratings lean SMU though.

TROY 29 UL-LAFAYETTE 21. Troy has won 4 straight games with backup QB Tucker Kilcrease. We do think it's been a little "fool's gold" as they were outgained in two of the games, two came via OT and last week they were +4 in turnovers. Now they face a ULL team that's lost four of their last 5 but we haven't seen quit from them as they are only -6 ppg and -54 ypg the last four games.

OKLAHOMA 27 Ole Miss 23. Huge game for SEC positioning and playoff positioning. Winner is in on pace to make the playoffs, the loser would have to win out. Ole Miss led Georgia 35-26 entering the fourth quarter but their offense disappeared. OU has made opposing offenses disappear all season as they are No. 1 in ypp and ypg. We were super impressed with their 26-7 win at South Carolina last week. They are better in ypp margin (+1.8 vs +1.4). Lean UNDER.

OHIO 34 Eastern Michigan 22. Eastern Michigan is playing a 9th straight week and we wonder if their defense is starting to wear down after allowing 44 to Miami last week. Outside of the second half vs Ball State, Ohio's been consistently solid all year. Lots of love for the OVER here. Our numbers say UNDER but we haven't bet it.

BOWLING GREEN 28 Kent State 18. BG comes in off the upset loss to CMU where their offense really struggled. QB Drew Pyne (leg) missed his 2nd straight game and is questionable here. Kent State led Toledo 10-0 only to get run out allowing 45 straight. Our numbers say BG -7 is a GO!

MIAMI, OH 24 Western Michigan 20. WMU comes in off the bye. The Broncos are 6-1 ATS this year covering their games by an average of 11.6 ppg. However, Miami has won 4 straight games and per usual are taking care of business in the MAC (19-2 last 21 MAC games). The RedHawks are the better team in the stats with a +0.9 ypp margin (WMU +0.1). We like Miami under a FG.

NORTHERN ILLINOIS 24 Ball State 19. NIU has been a mess this year. The Huskies are 1-6 ATS failing to cover their games by 6.4 ppg. They have the 2nd worst offense in the FBS averaging 4.4 ypp, 263 ypg and just 12.3 ppg. There's definitely more positive vibes around Ball State who's off a 42-28 win over Akron. Lots of money on the UNDER so far. We're passing.

NEBRASKA 27 Northwestern 17. Nebraska allowed NINE sacks last week and got dominated up front yet again in a 24-6 upset loss to Minnesota. Now they're facing a red-hot Northwestern team that's won four straight and shut out Purdue last week. Seems like an easy bet on Northwestern right? We prefer the Huskers in a bounce-back.

ARKANSAS 28 Auburn 26. Arkansas has lost 5 straight games. Auburn has lost 4 straight. Neither team has looked like they have waved the white flag on the season yet. We think the Arkansas offense that ranks No. 5 in ypp and No. 4 in ypg is the best unit on the field. Arkansas is better in ypp margin (+1.1 vs +0.4) and both have played Top 5 schedules in terms of difficulty. We're part of the Arkansas money that has flipped them to favorite here.

OLD DOMINION 36 Appalachian State 24. Old Dominion led James Madison 27-21. They got out-scored 42-0 to close the game and got out-gained 624-285. Appalachian State led Coastal Carolina 34-24. They lost outright. Both teams need a bounce back. The market likes ODU but we're passing.

IOWA 24 Minnesota 17. Don't look now but Iowa is 5-2 with their two losses to Iowa State and Indiana by a combined 8 points. They did get a comeback win over Penn State last week. Now they face a Minnesota team that is different with a healthy RB Darius Taylor. It gives their offense some balance and their defense got NINE sacks vs Nebraska last week. We like taking the points with low totals and very slow tempos. Series note: Iowa is 9-1 SU last 10.

KANSAS 28 Kansas State 26. Kansas State has beat Kansas 16 straight times. This is the first time since 2009 that Kansas State is an underdog to Kansas. Both teams off a bye. Kansas is better in the stats (+1.0 vs +0.3 ypp margin). We don't make many bets on series history anymore but until Kansas proves otherwise, we like Kansas State getting the FG here.

SOUTHERN MISS 30 UL-Monroe 20. We don't know how Charles Huff does it. Last year, Marshall under his leadership, won 9 games in the regular season despite being outgained. This year Southern Miss is 5-2 and they are -0.1 ypg. ULM actually out-gained Troy last week but lost by 23 as they were -4 in turnovers. We haven't bet side or total.

NEW MEXICO 31 Utah State 29. Key game for Mountain West bowl positioning from two first-year coaches. Bronco Mendenhall coached at New Mexico for one year and left for Utah State. Will there be bad blood? Utah State is better in the stats at +0.6 ypp margin (NM +0.1). We lean Utah State getting the FG.

UTAH 33 Colorado 17. Colorado comes in off a bye. Prior to it, the Buffs had their best performance of the season as they upset Iowa State. Utah is off another loss. Head coach Kyle Whittingham bypassed three different FG attempts in the game and were stopped on downs each time. Utah lost by 3 to rival BYU in a game where the Utes had a 470-368 yard edge. Our ratings like Utah here.

Texas 26 MISSISSIPPI STATE 20. Texas had 179 yards last week and won a football game. The OL is a mess and QB Arch Manning looks average. They have been bailed out by their defense and PR Niblett in recent weeks. Now they're facing a pesky Mississippi State team that already upset Arizona State here and nearly upset Tennessee and Florida. We lean with the Bulldogs.

San Diego State 25 FRESNO STATE 24. San Diego State has been super impressive this season. The Aztecs are 5-1 ATS covering their games by an average of 15.6 points per game. Head coach Sean Lewis is an offensive guy but the Aztecs defense ranks No. 4 in ypp and No. 5 in scoring. However, now they're playing with big expectations laying points on the road vs a solid Fresno State team.

LSU 25 Texas A&M 24. Unbeaten Texas A&M rolls in laying under a FG to a struggling LSU team off their first loss to Vanderbilt since 1990? Seems like an easy bet on A&M. We actually prefer the LSU side if the line gets to "+3". LSU is 19-1 SU in home night games under Brian Kelly. The Tigers' backs are against the wall. A loss would knock them out of the playoffs before the month of November.

Temple 29 TULSA 23. KC Keeler is one of the more underrated coaches in CFB the last two decades. He's got Temple 6-1 ATS with an average cover of 12.1 points per game. However, they're starting to play with expectations as they're laying a TD on the road to a Tulsa team off a bye. We didn't bet side or total.

VANDERBILT 28 Missouri 25. We couldn't have been more impressed with Vanderbilt last week. They were favored over LSU for the first time since 1948 and were favored for the first time in any SEC game since 2018. Safe to say they exceeded those expectations as they out-rushed LSU 239-100. Now ESPN College GameDay comes to town and it will be interesting to see how they handle more distractions and more expectations. Missouri has played two straight full efforts vs Alabama and Auburn and are traveling again.

IOWA STATE 26 BYU 23. This line certainly tells you a lot. 7-0 and No. 11 BYU is a 3-point underdog to Iowa State. Same spot as Georgia Tech at Duke last week and it worked out for the unbeaten team. We don't think that will be the case here. BYU is off a big win over arch rival Utah where they got out-gained by 102 yards. Iowa State is off a bye. We were expecting the line to be "Pick-Em". Pass.

Alabama 29 SOUTH CAROLINA 17. Alabama became the first team in SEC history to beat four straight ranked teams in four straight weeks. It was another misleading final as they got out-gained by Tennessee and the Tide got a 99-yard "Pick 6" on the final play of the first half. They are playing a hapless South Carolina team that lost 26-7 at home to Oklahoma last week. We didn't bet it yet.

South Florida 33 MEMPHIS 28. The look-ahead line on this game had Memphis -3.5...now USF is -5. An overreaction? We don't think so. Memphis lost outright as a 23.5-point favorite to a UAB team with an interim coach and a backup QB. Memphis also lost QB Brendon Lewis to injury and he is questionable here (we think he's doubtful). USF is a machine. They're 5-1-1 ATS covering their games by 12.7 ppg. In their last four games, USF has out-rushed their opponents by an average of 306-80 averaging 6.5 yards per carry while allowing just 2.5. USF starts making their run to the playoffs.

OREGON 40 Wisconsin 6. Wisconsin's offense has scored a total of 3 points since the opening drive vs Michigan. That's ZERO TD's in 172 minutes of game action. Oregon looked like a team on a mission last week as they piled up 750 yards at Rutgers. Our ratings don't call for it but we could only look towards Oregon here. Sooner or later that Wisconsin defense is going to break.

TEXAS TECH 47 Oklahoma State 10. Texas Tech comes in off their first loss of the season. How motivated will they be to get margin here? Will QB Behren Morton return? It might not matter as Oklahoma State is so feeble. The Cowboys are 1-6 ATS failing to cover their games by 11.5 ppg. We're passing.

WASHINGTON 29 Illinois 25. A playoff eliminator here as both teams already have two losses. Washington has been better in the stats (+1.7 vs +0.6 in ypp margin) but spot says Illinois off the bye. Keep an eye on the weather forecast as a major front is expected to hit the Pacific Northwest this weekend (it would also impact the Wisconsin/Oregon and Toledo/Washington State games).

ARIZONA STATE 28 Houston 21. Arizona State comes in off the upset of Top 10 Texas Tech where they stormed the field. We usually like fading teams off those kind of wins. Houston has been better in the stats but has played a much weaker schedule. Our ratings say Arizona State but the spot says Houston.

NAVY 38 Florida Atlantic 23. Navy is 6-0 and coming off a bye. Their offense has been super explosive this year as they are averaging 7.6 yards per play No. 4. FAU runs a lot of tempo on offense but haven't been efficient for 60 minutes in most games. It's a game we don't have an interest in currently.

WASHINGTON STATE 24 Toledo 23. If you've watched Washington State the last two weeks, you might wonder how in the world could they only be a 1.5-point favorite here? They only lost to Ole Miss by 3 as 33-point underdogs and then only lost to Virginia by 2. Meanwhile, Toledo has a couple of losses as a big favorite. The problem is Toledo blew big leads in both games and have covered each of their other 5 games. Tough handicap.

ARKANSAS STATE 30 Georgia Southern 29. Arkansas State comes in off back-to-back outright upsets as a huge underdog. Now they're laying points to a team that is better in the stats than them (-1.2 ypp margin vs -1.8). Georgia Southern games are 6-1 to the OVER but Arkansas State has had 5 straight games go UNDER.

Tennessee 33 KENTUCKY 23. Tennessee is 37-3 SU vs Kentucky since 1985. They're 21-7 ATS in the series since 1997. Both teams coming off losses last week where they won the box score. Lean UT.

WYOMING 25 Colorado State 21. Border War has seen Wyoming win 7 of the last 9 meetings. The Rams fired head coach Norvell after last week's home upset loss to Hawaii. Wyoming has been better in the stats (+0.4 vs -1.0). Teams have been getting one game bumps with interim coaches this year. We're passing.

We think it's the best value bets we make all week. 2020 was the first season where we tracked every single bet we made and posted them in the weekly newsletters. We were very pleased with our 119-76-3 (61%) record on these Sunday bets with an average line value of 2.6 ppg! In 2021, we were 224-196-5 (53.3%) vs the Circa openers with an average line value of 1.8 ppg. In 2022, we were 314-262-14 (54.5%, CLV 417-122-51 +1.65 ppg). In 2023, we were 405-358-6 (53.4%, CLV 577-137-55 +2.09 ppg). Games in Rotation Order

Thursday, October 23rd

L.A. CHARGERS 25 Minnesota 22. Both teams need a win. The Vikings have lost two of the last 3 and allowed 7.4 yards per play to the Eagles last week. The Chargers have lost 3 of their last 4 games failing to cover the spread in all four. The Chargers defense has been leaky allowing 30.7 ppg the last 3 games and their OL remains banged up. LAC is better in the stats at +0.3 in ypp margin vs a tougher schedule (Minny is +0.2). We lean Minny getting the hook and the OVER which is 5-1 in Minnesota games this year.

Sunday, October 26th

CINCINNATI 24 N.Y. Jets 20. The Jets are 0-7 SU and their offense is really struggling the last few weeks. They have scored just 17 points and head coach Aaron Glenn is in over his head. The Bengals did get the upset win over the Steelers last Thursday as Joe Flacco was 31 of 47 for 342 yards and 3 TD's. He basically threw to WR Ja'Marr Chase on half his attempts as Chase had 16 receptions for 161 yards. Cincy is actually worse than the Jets in ypp margin (-1.4 vs -0.8) and they rank No. 29 in DVOA (Jets No. 27). The Bengals have played the much tougher schedule (No. 3 vs No. 26). We can't lay this kind of number with Cincy no matter who is behind center for New York.

HOUSTON 23 San Francisco 20. The Texans are on a short week after losing at Seattle on MNF. Meanwhile, the 49ers got a big win over Atlanta on SNF. San Francisco was actually a 1-point home underdog as some big groups came in against them on Sunday. RB McCaffrey had his 1st 200-yard from scrimmage game in 6 years and the 49ers moved to 4-1 under QB Mac Jones. Houston is better in ypp margin (+0.3 vs +0.0), ranked higher in Sagarin (No. 10 vs No. 15) and also ranked higher in DVOA (No. 8 vs No. 18) while playing a tougher schedule (No. 7 vs No. 19). If WR Collins is a go, we like Houston.

BALTIMORE 27 Chicago 20. Lamar Jackson returned to practice on Wednesday. The Ravens are off a bye and desperately need him if they are going to turn their season around after a 1-5 SU and 1-5 ATS start. Somehow the Bears have won and covered 4 games in a row. They are still -0.6 in ypp margin (No. 26) while Baltimore is +0.0 in ypp (No. 16). Baltimore ranks higher in Sagarin and has played the tougher schedule. Will Lamar show some rust? We lean Baltimore and UNDER despite the OVER having a 5-1 mark in Baltimore games this year.

ATLANTA 26 Miami 19. It was another embarrassing loss for the Dolphins who somehow lost by 25 to a feeble Cleveland team. QB Tagovailoa threw three picks again. Now they're facing an Atlanta team off a SNF loss to the 49ers where they got bet to a road favorite. Qb Penix is a bit dinged up but we think Atlanta would be a solid teaser option this week. When will the Dolphins fire Mike McDaniel? Has Tua also lost the locker-room? Atlanta games are 5-1 to the UNDER but Miami games are 6-1 to the OVER. Pass.

Buffalo 28 CAROLINA 20. Buffalo comes in off the bye after losing two straight as a favorite. The Bills have failed to cover each of their last 4 games. The Panthers counter with a 3-game win and cover streak. Two have come against the lowly Dolphins and Jets but we're not sure anyone had the Panthers 4-3 at this point in the season (win total was 6.5). The Bills are much better in the stats (+0.3 vs -0.3 in ypp margin) and also the Sagarin ratings (No. 5 vs No. 25). We like the "buy low, sell high" aspect of this one. The Bills are one of our favorite teaser legs.

PHILADELPHIA 26 N.Y. Giants 18. These two just played on October 9th where the Giants pulled the shocker winning 34-17 as 7.5-point home underdogs. Now they find themselves 7.5-point underdogs at Philadelphia. The Giants had an historic loss on Sunday. NFL teams were on a 1,602-0 run when leading by 18 points in the final six minutes. That record is now 1,602-1 as the G-Men blew a 26-8 lead and lost 33-32 to Denver. We expect that loss to linger here vs a Philly team that got back on track vs Minnesota last week. Shocker, we like Philly in a teaser.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

NEW ENGLAND 23 Cleveland 17. New England has won and covered four straight games. They have done well as a sizable favorite with a blowout of Carolina at home and then beat Tennessee 31-13 as a 6.5-point road favorite last week. Cleveland is coming off their 2nd win of the season. The Browns topped 17 points for the first time this season and their defense is allowing just 4.5 yards per play (No. 3). New England is better in the stats (+0.1 vs -0.4 in ypp margin) but Cleveland has played the tougher schedule. We can't lay 7 here.

Tampa Bay 25 NEW ORLEANS 21. Tampa comes in off the short week after getting dominated by Detroit. The Bucs were out-gained 379-251 and were -2.0 in yards per play. For the season they are only +0.1 in ypp despite a 5-2 record. New Orleans is -0.6 in ypp margin. Despite the market loving them last week (bet from +5.5 to +3.5), they fell 26-14 at Chicago. We don't have a strong take here. Pass.

INDIANAPOLIS 30 Tennessee 17. The 1-6 Titans have only covered 5 of their last 24 games. They're off a blowout loss to former coach Vrabel who was cheered by the Titans' fans. Tennessee ranks dead last in ypp margin (-1.6) and also dead last in DVOA. Indianapolis has been the surprise of the NFL season so far at 6-1 SU and 5-2 ATS. The Colts are No. 4 in ypp margin (+0.9) and rank No. 3 in DVOA. They are off to their best start since 2009. However, winning games and laying 2 TD's is a different story. They did beat the Titans by 21 back on September 21st but we're not interested in laying it here.

DENVER 27 Dallas 25. How will Denver respond to one of the more improbable wins in NFL history. They trailed the Giants by 18 with 6 minutes left and became the first team in 1,603 games to win with those circumstances. Dallas is off their best performance of the season as they beat Washington 44-22. They've been Jekyll and Hyde all year but their offense remains one of the best in the NFL while their defense is one of the worst. We lean with them getting the hook though.

Green Bay 24 PITTSBURGH 23. Two of the most successful franchises in NFL history. Neither has won a Super Bowl since their Super Bowl meeting 15 years ago. Obviously, you have Aaron Rodgers going against his former team. The Packers are the better tea, on the stats with a +1.2 ypp margin (No. 2) vs Pittsburgh's +0.1 (No. 14). However, the spot says Pittsburgh here as the Steelers have extra time to prep off their surprising Thursday Night loss to the Bengals. Meanwhile, the Packers are traveling again after a close win over the Cardinals. Green Bay has been over-priced in the markets with a 0-4 ATS run. Make it 0-5.

Monday, October 27th

KANSAS CITY 28 Washington 17. A lot of luster has been taking from this game with QB Daniels out for Washington. The look-ahead line was only KC -5.5. The Chiefs buried the Raiders 31-0. It was worse than the final as the Chiefs had a 434-95 yard edge. You read that right, the Chiefs defense limited the Raiders to 95 yards on only 30 plays. Meanwhile, the Commanders were crushed by the Cowboys 44-22. Add all those results with the QB injury and you get a massive move. With that being said, this line seems a bit pricey and we'll lean with Washington "+13".
