

SCHEDULE for GARBAGE, TRASH & RECYCLABLES

Garbage:	Wednesday & Saturday	AFTER 6 PM NIGHT BEFORE PICK UP BUT BEFORE 6 AM DAY OF PICK UP	In Lane at designated spot
Recyclables:	Wednesday	AFTER 6:00 PM TUESDAY OR BEFORE 6:00 AM WEDNESDAY	In Lane at designated spot
<u>Yellow Bin:</u> Newspapers, paper bags, corrugated cardboard boxes (must be broken down)	Wednesday	AFTER 6:00 PM TUESDAY OR BEFORE 6:00 AM WEDNESDAY	In Lane at designated spot
<u>Blue Bin:</u> Aluminum cans, foil, glass bottles, plastic containers 1 & 2, milk & juice cartons, drink boxes.	Wednesday	AFTER 6:00 PM TUESDAY OR BEFORE 6:00 AM WEDNESDAY	In Lane at designated spot
Bulk Trash: 772- 546-7700	Wednesday	AFTER 6:00 PM TUESDAY BUT BEFORE 6:00 AM WEDNESDAY	On Circle near street but not near signs and trees
Vegetation: (Leaves, tree trimmings, etc.) cut into lengths of no more than 4' and bagged where possible	Wednesday	AFTER 6:00 PM TUESDAY BUT BEFORE 6:00 AM WEDNESDAY	On Circle near street but <u>not near signs and trees</u>

Call Solid Waste Authority, 561-697-2700, to find locations for discarding hazardous waste such as oil, oil based paint or vehicle batteries. Do not put out hazardous waste for garbage pick-up. After trash cans are emptied; return them to the unit within 24 hours. If collection falls on a holiday, it will be rescheduled to the next pick up day.

GARBAGE MUST BE IN A TRASH BAG AND THEN PLACED IN A PLASTIC WASTE CONTAINER WITH A LID. MARK THE CAN WITH YOUR UNIT NUMBER. USE BUNGEE CORDS IF LID DOES NOT FIT PROPERLY. GARBAGE NOT IN A TRASH CAN IS A VIOLATION.

Waste Management requires the trash containers to be no bigger than 32 -50 lbs each.

Recyclables must be segregated from garbage and placed in the YELLOW and BLUE containers that are provided by Waste Management. Mark your unit number on yellow and blue bins. Please do not put garbage in recycle bins.

IF YOUR REFUSE IS NOT COLLECTED BY EARLY EVENING, RETURN IT TO YOUR UNIT UNTIL THE NEXT SCHEDULED COLLECTION DAY.

Fines will be issued to owners for violations of the garbage schedule.

Trash / Bulk Items

Trash / Bulk items are collected 1 time per week on Wednesday Morning around the ring road to the Community. You may put bulk trash out as early as late Tuesday afternoon.

Do not place any items out at the road any earlier than late Tuesday afternoon.

What items are **Bulk Items**?

Discarded furniture and appliances as well as other household items including toilets, bathtubs, water softeners, and similar household goods that will not fit into a standard garbage can is collected once per week and may be placed at the main road in designated locations. Your regular trash should be placed in your numbered trash can in your lane.

Do not mix bulk items with vegetation.



Construction Debris

Debris from minor home repairs such as replacing a rotted piece of trim or a broken tile. Construction debris is limited to 2 cubic yards per collection day (equal to a standard size refrigerator) and must follow the 50/50 rule. Debris must be containerized in sealed plastic bags. Containers and contents can weigh no more than 50 pounds. Carpeting must be cut to 4 foot lengths, rolled up and weigh less than 50 pounds.

Your waste hauler is not required to collect any debris that does not meet the above guide-lines. If your debris does not meet guidelines and is not collected you may do one of the following:

- Correct the debris to meet required collection guidelines.
- Contact your current waste hauler for their contracted special service fee.
- Contact any other private hauler listed in the Yellow Pages under “Rubbish Removal” for their collection rate.
- Transport the material directly to [SWA’s Customer Convenience Drop-Off Center](#) at North County Landfill located at 6330 North Jog Road in West Palm Beach (west of the Turnpike, between 45th Street and the Beeline Highway). If you elect to transport the material to the landfill please be aware you will be charged for the disposal cost and cash is required.

Household Hazardous Waste

Household hazardous waste is **never** collected curbside. Examples of household hazardous waste are:

- Antifreeze
- Automotive batteries
- Automotive body fillers
- Brake fluid
- Diesel fuel
- Engine cleaners
- Engine degreasers
- Flares (marine, road)
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Gasoline
- Oil (automotive)
- Oil filters

Hobby & Miscellaneous Supplies

- Ammunition
- Batteries - NiCad (rechargeable)
- Computers
- Fireworks
- Flea powder
- Gun cleaners
- Lighter fluid
- Nail polish remover
- Photo chemicals
- Televisions

Home Maintenance

- Ammonia
- Bleach
- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Mercury switches (from thermostats)
- Mercury thermometers
- Mineral spirits
- Paint (oil based)
- Paint thinners

Lawn & Garden

- Fungicides
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Pesticides
- Weed killers

Outdoor & Pool

- Chlorine
- Muriatic acid
- Pool and spa chemicals
- Propane cylinders

Household hazardous waste may be dropped at any SWA designated Household Hazardous Waste collection site at no charge to Palm Beach County residents. There is no appointment necessary. The closest one is just 3.5 miles north at 14185 Military Trail (SWA Road), Jupiter, FL 33458
