MONTHLY MEETING McDowell Mountain Ranch McDowell Center Scottsdale, AZ Nov 14, 2019

Call to Order

2nd Vice-Chairman Rich Rutkowski called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Arthur Cooper led prayer and Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Speakers

Arthur Cooper, as General George C. Patton – Trump Reelection Committee

- Joined Trump election committee to keep AZ red.
- On mission to find Republicans who are not voting and get them to vote in 2020. Millennials are dividing as the younger are growing up under Trump, not Obama. AZ needs to deliver 11 electoral votes for Trump.

Ryan Stone – guest speaker, Border Patrol Officer – ICE Deportation Officer:

- Spoke of loopholes with illegal aliens staying in the US with purchased children.
- Noted there are 26 ICE field offices in the US, Phoenix being one of the busiest.
- Discussed the high costs of housing illegals: Florence has 1800 beds, Eloy has 1600 beds. Always full. Because there is no space, there are "alternatives" to detention. Started using bracelets for electric monitoring so that they show up at a hearing 3 or more years in the future.
- Tucson is one of the most liberal cities in AZ. Sanctuary city bill defeated by 70% of voters shows sign of overall conservative support.
- Removal of illegal aliens is ICE's key duty. 250,000 illegal aliens removed in 2019
- At Mesa Gateway, there are air operations by US government using three 737's. These planes are used to deport illegals, 2 missions a day southbound, \$10,000 / flight.
- South of the border we get news coverage because Americans were involved, but murders are commonplace with natives. Americans are usually hands-off. Cartels are part of every industry in Mexico including avocado producers like a modern-day mafia.
- Old cartels permission was needed to kill someone. Now, lower level members are able to act on their immediate feelings – young, dumb guys with massive firepower. Executions are common. Violence escalating to effect private citizens, not just cartel members.
- Drones are a new big issue as they drop their payloads over the border. Technology needs to be introduced to help manage the situation.
- 21% in Federal Bureau of Prisons are illegal aliens. 8% of AZ Department of Corrections inmates are illegal. Average cost is \$25,000 annually per illegal. =

- \$950 million annually is spent in Federal prisons, \$87 million. \$300 million spent removing aliens from the United States.
- Threats are made daily on the lives of ICE and border patrol agents by liberals. Protestors call agents by their names, shout out their addresses and where their children go to school.
