1894 - 1970

Alfred Gascho, 76, former resident of Elkton, died Wednesday, January 13 at his home in Romeo following a lengthy illness.

He was born October 11, 1894, in Elkton. His early years were spent in Elkton, after which he moved to Detroit. Mr. Gascho studied for the ministry and served as pastor of Au Gres Methodist Church and the Sutton and Sunshine Churches in the Caro area. He retired from the pulpit in 1961 and became caretaker at the Romeo campgrounds.

He married Lulu Coote, September 20, 1916.
