### A&P MECHANIC /TECHNICIAN

Provide mechanical and technical support for maintenance and refurbishment of military equipment, mechanical assemblies, custom components, and metal hardware for the Naval Surface Warfare Center Panama City Division (NSWC PCD). The A&P Mechanic/Technician is responsible for the inspection, repair, maintenance, and overhaul of the Airborne Mine Counter Measures (AMCM) systems - MK-105 Magnetic Minesweeping Gear. Technicians will examine metal materials, assess deterioration, and record evaluation results to improve condition of equipment based on government specifications and priority schedule at the Depot Repair Facility (DRF). This should include the ability to drill and rivet thin sheet metal and the ability to read and use detail and assembly blueprints. Prefer candidates who can demonstrate past performance with mechanical and electrical sub-assemblies.

### REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be U.S. Citizen
- High School graduate or equivalent
- A&P Mechanic/Technician Certificate preferred
- Must have 3 years direct experience as an airframe mechanic or technician.
- Must have active or documented security clearance in last two years.

### BASIC QUALIFICATIONS:

- Three years of aircraft sheet metal assembly (riveted structure and installation of functional and/or electrical components) experience and equivalent training.
- Specific US Navy or DOD job experience preferred demonstrating knowledge in reading and interpreting maintenance procedures in accordance with technical drawings and specifications.
- Production, fabrication, refurbishment of sheet metal products and equipment using specialized tooling, manual machining, welding, metal finishing of structural repairs.
- Assist with project solutions for parts obsolescence and improvements for repair and maintenance.
- Must be able to follow maintenance procedures, quality assurance guidelines, safety requirements.
- Candidates must be a team player with good communication, written, and problem solving skills.
- Must be able to lift, carry, and pull up to 50 lbs. in loading equipment or supplies
- Applicants with OSHA certifications and/or previous government training preferred.
