

Ant Checklist

Crazy ants are attracted by sweet or greasy foods. Carpenter ants destroy wood and are usually found in damp wood. Pharaoh ants are very small, difficult to control and nest throughout structures. Fire ants nest in soil and in voids like hollow doors and walls but are fortunately only rarely found in Iowa.



1. In the area you are having problems with ants, we want you to wait till we get to your home before you move anything. We want to see where the ants are traveling to and from.
2. After we assess the area you might need to move things then. (off counters, out of cabinets)
3. We want our product to be dry before any one walks over it. If you will be around while we service your home, please have on shoes or slippers so not to get the product on your feet.
4. If you can keep small children from following the technician around that would be best.
5. If you have a dog, please put them outside or in a kennel while we service indoors and bring them back inside when we need to go outside to finish your service.
6. If you have a fish tank please cover it with a sheet and turn off the pumps.
7. It will be very helpful to have all items away from the baseboards in all rooms, (children's and pets toys, clothes, boxes)if you prefer not to prepare for the service we will just not service that area. Your coverage will just be limited.
8. We prefer not to service infants rooms, if you want us to please cover their beds with a sheet and launder it after service.
9. Please try to wash all wood/vinyl floors before your service, we do not want you to wash away the product till your insect problems are resolved.
10. Vacuum will not harm our products.
