# Three Crowns Farm Summer Camp



We can't wait to see you!

Thank you for participating in one of our summer camps this year. Please find below some information to get you ready for camp. See you soon!

## Mission:

The mission of Three Crowns Farm is to provide a safe atmosphere where children of all ages can come and have a great time riding horses, being in a farm environment, participating in fun games and art projects, and enjoy other animals around the farm in a fun and positive environment.

## What to bring:

All campers are required to bring a packed lunch. Campers will want to bring \$1-\$2 per day for the treat store. Most kids like to purchase at least one item for an afternoon snack, and do not like being left out. Be prepared with a bathing suit daily. We may not have water play every day, but will have it scheduled as an activity for two or three days, so come prepared daily. Be sure you label your items. We will have a lost and found basket and we encourage parents to check it at the end of the week. *Hint: Duct tape in the sole of a shoe with your Childs name sharpied on works great?* Campers may also want a grocery sack packed into their bag to place their boots/tennis shoes in when changing into bathing suits. Most days they will be in their bathing suits at pick up time, and may not want to stuff their shoes into their backpack. We highly recommend all campers to apply sunscreen (all over, as if you had on a bathing suit) once before coming to camp each morning. Campers will be able to reapply sunscreen after lunch each day. Our staff will assist the youngest campers with proper application.

## Attire:

Closed toe shoes with socks are a must on the farm! No open toe shoes of any kind. Tennis shoes or boots are best. Helmets are provided; however if you have one of your very own please bring it along (Name MUST be labeled on helmet/no bicycle helmets allowed). Please wear pants suitable for riding (jeans, riding pants, thick legging). You may bring a pair of shorts/flip flops to change into after lunch if you wish. Rain or Shine our camp will go on, so please be prepared. We do not ride during extreme heavy rains, storms or unseasonably high temperatures. If such extreme weather conditions occur the Three Crown Farm staff will provide indoor and "in barn" activities for your camper. There's always plenty of grooming, animal care and fun to be had. We also have a large basement in case of severe weather.

## Safety:

Your child's safety comes first at Three Crowns Farm. Our horses are experienced with children and know their job well. Still, we remind campers often of general safety rules around animals. Only campers are allowed out of their vehicle at drop off and pick up. Siblings and non-campers are not allowed to play on the farm. Please do not allow siblings to play in the barns and on the play sets at the farm. If your child has any allergies or medical conditions please let us know prior to camp.

## Rules:

Campers are expected to respect the Three Crowns Staff, the farm animals and the farm itself. Thank goodness we have never had an issue with this. We are blessed with some wonderful kids! There are no electronic devices allowed during camp hours. No cell phones or smart watches!

Getting your camper ready and excited for camp:

Many new campers enjoy viewing pictures of our past camps on our facebook page. There should be plenty of pictures under 'camp albums' to get your camper excited!

Camp Sessions:

Campers can sign up for multiple camp weeks. We have many that spend the whole summer with us. We do our best to make sure your child's experience each week is fun and full of different activities. Many of our activities include horsemanship, art class, time with other farm animals, games, water play activities, and so much more.

A Typical Day of Horse Camp: (Schedules may differ per day)

9:30 Riding Groups Begin

12:00 Lunch

12:20 Games-Farm Animals

12:50 Arts and Crafts

1:50 Water Balloons, Chicken Races or other activities – Some days = Bareback Class

3:00 Pick Up

*\*Early drop off and pick up may be arranged at an additional \$10 per day fee, due at the first morning of camp.*

**Payment:**

A \$100 non-refundable deposit reserves your spot in your chosen camp week(s). The balance of the session fee will be due the first morning of your camp.
