

Mundito Foundation Annual report 2013

Mundito is...

- **Two founders** who search out worthy projects, cover all operating expenses, and cover half of the target grant amount for each campaign,
- Three board members who help find and design projects, provide due diligence, and help spread the good word about how you can change lives,
- A small army of extraordinary donors who dig deep to help us solve a few of the world's problems. That's it. No employees, minimal expenses. We strive for staggering efficiency and we hope you agree that we achieved this in 2013.

Now seven years old, Mundito Foundation is completing 14th campaign and has changed the lives of thousands of individuals around the world. Mundito serves as a "giving group", undertaking projects with partner nonprofit organizations that meet our objectives:

Specific. Efficient. Changing lives.

By combining forces, we and our donors can undertake larger projects – and have greater impact – than would otherwise be possible. Our annual spring campaign works with a nonprofit that serves a domestic population; our annual fall campaign works with a nonprofit that serves the developing world.

Projects funded in 2013:

- Freedom (Nepal, Fall 2012 campaign): In early 2013, we completed a campaign with Free the Slaves to support their work liberating and rehabilitating slaves and preventing trafficking in Nepal. \$15,500 was provided for this program in 2013, for a total of \$30,500.
- Enrichment (Atlanta, Spring 2013 campaign): We launched and completed a campaign with Atlanta Children's Shelter to add enrichment activities to their preschool curriculum for homeless children. Our total grant to ACS was \$20,200.
- Secondary education (Burkina Faso, Fall 2013 campaign): We launched a campaign with Plan International USA to provide secondary-school scholarships to girls in Burkina Faso. This campaign was by far our most successful to date. We reached our target grant of \$32,000 in 2013. (The total grant for this project, including the final installment in 2014, was \$38,400.)

Table 1 at the end of this report shows the results of all campaigns undertaken since Mundito was founded in 2007.

Growth:

2013 was a year of remarkable growth for Mundito Foundation. We are supported by a growing and extraordinarily enthusiastic pool of donors, a total of 82 for our two campaigns in 2013. Our two 2013 campaigns averaged 61 donors, well above the levels of 2012 (45), 2011 (41), 2010 (45) and 2009 (42). Total donations showed significant increases as well. Donations to our domestic campaign, at \$11,186, were similar to results from the prior year, but our international campaign was a breakaway success: donations of \$22,188 were far beyond our target (\$16,000) and well above our previous high-water mark (\$15,120 in Fall 2012 with Free the Slaves). As agency donations grow, so do our commitments to our nonprofit partners. Over the period 2007-2013, Mundito has provided over \$274k to our nonprofit partners.

Expenses:

All agency donations (i.e. donations not made by the Founding Directors) flow directly to our nonprofit partners; all administrative and fundraising expenses (and half of the target grants) are covered by the Founding Directors. Expenses for Mundito Foundation continue to be very low. Over the past several years, our administrative and fundraising expenses have remained relatively constant, while our grants have been increasing. A breakdown of our cash expenses for 2013 is as follows:

98% Program expenses (grants to partner nonprofits, including agency donations and Mundito general fund)

2% Administrative expenses (primarily tax filing)

<1% Fundraising (mostly stamps and office supplies)

Mundito has no salary expenses, makes no payments to board members, and makes no payments for the use of office space and equipment. Total cash administrative and fundraising expenses for 2013 were \$1,544. As noted above, all such expenses are covered by the Founding Directors.

Governance:

- Peter Vantine joined the board in September 2012 and will serve on the board as Outside Director through March 2015. (Peter replaced another board member mid-term.)
- David Gittelman joined the board in October 2012 for a three-year term as Outside Director. He replaced Amalia Stevens, who retired from the board in September 2013.
- Founding Directors Richard Higgins and Margaret Graff continue as permanent members of the board.
- Lynn Fountain, Tom Murphy, and Amalia Stevens continue working with Mundito as Board Members Emeritus.
