





#### TOP CIRCULATING NON-FICTION TITLES





### LIBRARY EVENTS

Sherrard Public Library District offers a variety of events for all age groups, including Crafts, Book Clubs, Take Home Book Bundles, and more!







#### **BOOK BUNDLES**



We offer three book bundle programs: Take Home Storytime Bags, Tween & Teen Book Bundles, and Adult Take a Book Break! Each bundle comes with library books (librarian's choice, the only item to return), crafts, and surprises!

Bundles are packaged for a quick pick-up that keeps your family enjoying the library - even when you're too busy to browse! Over 500 bundles were sent home this year.

#### **STORYTIME**

Join us for read aloud stories and crafts at Storytime! Storytime helps children learn social and listening skills, expand vocabulary, and broad imagination - all while having fun with their friends! Children through age 12 are welcome - perfect for homeschooling families.



#### **BOOK CLUBS**

Sherrard Library hosts two monthly book clubs with 31 members to discuss titles from various genres. Members have a library copy automatically held under their account for convenient pick-up, and registration for monthly meetings is not required. Ask the front desk to get started!

#### **CRAFTS**

A variety of crafts are offered throughout the year for children, teens, and adults! Take Home Crafts offer children and teens to stay creative around their busy schedule, while adults can enjoy both Take Home and In-Person options. Learn new skills and connect with your neighbors!




# READING PROGRAMS

Each Summer, the Library offers a reading program that helps your family prevent the "summer slide" in reading skills through engaging goals and rewards. This year, 100 community members participated in Summer Reading, with 366 program completions!

## LITTLE SPROUTS 1,000 BOOKS BEFORE KINDERGARTEN

Children ages 0-5 are eligible to participate in 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten, available year-round. Families can read any book with their little sprout to participate, and children will be rewarded for their progress per every 100 books read! This is a great program for budding readers, as it sows the pre-reading skills necessary for academic success.



Families can start their 1,000 Books journey anytime before Kindergarten! Visit our front desk for more information and to receive reading logs.

### HIGHLIGHTS

#### FINE FREE CARDS

Patrons 17 and under, or 62 and over do not incur fines when checking out at Sherrard Library! Fine free cards are a stress-free way to enjoy the library.

#### **COMMUNITY PASSES**

Sherrard Library patrons may check-out passes which grant household admission to local attractions, including Figge Art Museum, The German-American Heritage Center, Niabi Zoo, Putnam Museum, and Quad City Botanical Center.

Or, rent a FunBundle - admission to Niabi Zoo, Putnam Museum, and QC Botanical Center all one card!

#### **EBOOKS & EAUDIOBOOKS**

Can't make it to the library? Check out thousands of eBooks and eAudiobooks using Libby or Boundless! Use your Sherrard Library Card number as username, and the last four digits of your library barcode number as your PIN to access these apps for free. Automated returns mean you'll never have to pay an overdue fine!

#### **IMAGINATIVE PLAY SECTION**

A cozy section made for light play, children can engage in imaginative play to foster creativity, problem-solving, and social skills.
