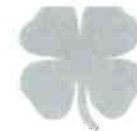

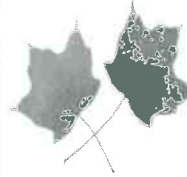


It's that time of year again!

In addition we also see dirt, mold and mildew on our houses, driveways and sidewalks.



 If your property has a fence please check to see if it needs to be cleaned.

Please take a moment to survey your property to see if anything needs to be taken care of. Property owners are responsible for maintaining the exterior of their properties per our rules and regulations.

Remember, any modifications or additions to the exterior of your house/property require the submittal of a site plan application. These can be found on our website or in the lobby at the clubhouse.
