**ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 2017-16 AUTHORIZING THE CARRYING
OF CONCEALED WEAPONS IN VILLAGE BUILDINGS AND ON
VILLAGE PROPERTY BY VALID CONCEALED CARRY PERMITHOLDERS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, consistent with Ohio Revised Section 2923.126, Council of Amelia Village (“Village Council”) passed Ordinance 2017-16 to allow all valid Ohio concealed carry permit holders to carry their legally permitted concealed weapons in Amelia Village (the “Village”) buildings and on Village property except in the Amelia Village Police Department building and anywhere the Amelia Village Mayor’s Court is being conducted during court hours.

WHEREAS, Village Council now seeks to amend Ordinance 2017-16 to allow for concealed carry in certain Village buildings and on certain Village property by valid concealed carry permit holders from certain other states as permitted by Ohio law.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Clermont County, Ohio, that Ordinance 2017-16 shall be amended in its entirety as follows;

SECTION I. For purposes of this Ordinance, a “concealed carry permit holder” shall be any person holding a valid Ohio concealed carry permit issued under section 2923.125 or 2923.1213 of the Ohio Revised Code or a valid concealed carry permit issued by another state with which the attorney general has entered into a reciprocity agreement under section 109.69 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION II: The Council of Amelia Village finds that all valid concealed carry permit holders shall be permitted to carry their legally permitted concealed weapons in Village buildings and on Village property except in the Amelia Village Police Department building and anywhere the Amelia Village Mayor’s Court is being conducted during court hours, or any other location prohibited by Ohio law.

SECTION III. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village. The reason for such necessity is to ensure the safety of residents of Amelia. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

SECTION IV. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this legislation were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
