








Saturday September 15 RSVP Deadline for Milt's Stage Stop

Members of the Month – George & Rozie Pasley

Rozie and I met at 30,000 feet on a Singapore Airlines 747 bound for Hong Kong. Rozie was a Leading Stewardess (yes, they still call them that today) working the flight and I was one of her passengers.




