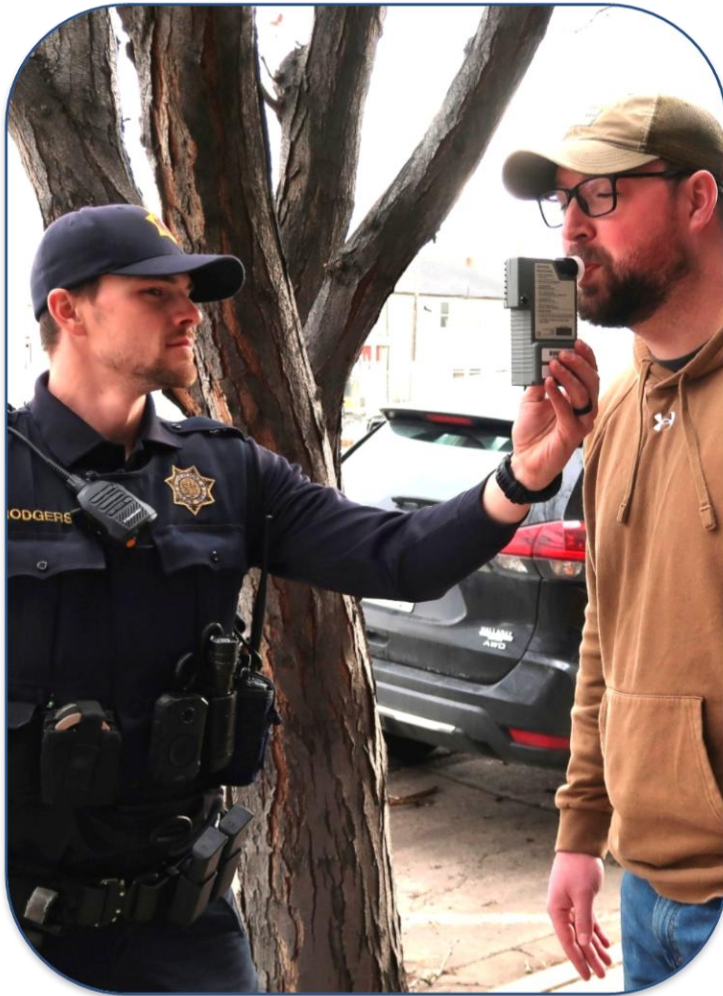

These reports provide the data analysis necessary for state and community leaders, prevention specialists, and law enforcement administrators to devise and implement effective strategies to reduce substance-involved crime in Wyoming. ### INTRODUCTION

The report contains alcohol-related information collected in all twenty-three counties in the State of Wyoming for a period of twelve months (January 1 through December 31, 2023) by the Wyoming Association of Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police. Information was collected from a total of 7,953 persons who were arrested and subsequently detained in a county detention facility.

This report provides detailed county specific alcohol-related information and is a supplement to the Alcohol and Crime in Wyoming – 2023<sup>1</sup> report.
