SCHOOL NEWS~CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE~Many of you know that the school began a capital campaign in 2010 which was paused in 2013. We are grateful to all of you who supported us in that initial effort. I wanted to briefly provide you with an update on the School Capital Campaign project. In Feb of 2017, a new committee formed to reinstate the capital campaign for the school. Since that time, the committee has met monthly to identify private donors and foundations who would be interested in supporting our parish school. With Father Rene's blessing, we have now submitted grants to potential foundations and are in early conversations with possible individual donors. Father Rene has asked us to publicly relaunch the Saint Olaf Capital Campaign after our Saint Olaf Feast day celebration. As a result, we are targeting August for our Public Capital Campaign Launch. We are hopeful that we will be able to raise funds necessary to refurbish our current building and add an addition for new classrooms and a dining area.
