

ERWIN "DICK" SATOW 1906 - 1996



Erwin "Dick" Satow, 89, longtime Sebawaing businessman and furniture store owner, died Monday, April 15, in Huron County Medical Care Facility, Bad Axe, following a two-year illness.

He was born in Unionville on June 20, 1906, the son of William and Christine (Schwenk) Satow. He was graduated from Sebawaing High School, Class of 1925. He was united in marriage with Hilda T. Spomer on March 27, 1932, in Sebawaing. She preceded him in death in September, 1967.

Mr. Satow had owned and operated Satow's Home of Fine Furnishings in Sebawaing from 1946 until his retirement in 1968, when he sold the business to his daughter, Betty, and her husband, the late Richard Mason.

He was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church and had served on the Board of Trustees and Board of Education. He was past president of Sebawaing Rotary Club, and a former member of Sebawaing Lions and Sebawaing Chamber of Commerce.

Surviving are one daughter and one son and their spouses, Betty and Foy Engelhardt of Sebawaing and Charles and Sherron Satow, St. Louis, MO, four grandchildren and spouses, Sharon Mason of Chicago, Kathy and William Backe of Milwaukee, Sally and Leonard Comer of Sebawaing, and Susan Satow of Florida, one step-granddaughter and husband, Beverly and Jeffrey Tietz of Unionville, two great-grandchildren and three step-great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

One sister, Gertrude Markel, and two brothers, Arnold and Clarence Satow, preceded him in death.

The funeral service took place at 11 a.m. Thursday, April 18, in Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home, Sebawaing, with Rev. Martin Hagenow officiating. Burial was in St. John Cemetery, Sebawaing.
