DESCRIPTION: Nice reconditioned Ben Pearson Special. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Tips are in good condition. No drilled holes; No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. There is a bit of discoloration and some marks in the glass near the top of one limb (see last pic). These occur in about 2% of vintage recurves, most often in Bear branded bows. These marks are **not** stress marks, but thought to be minor flaws in the glass resin. The decal is in excellent condition. Overall, this is a solid hunting bow in pretty good condition for its age. The Special was a mid-priced bow that was not part of the Pearson catalog lineup, but sold to big box and sporting goods stores of the day.
