Priorities on AV bill ensure motorcycles are part of all testing & development. Manufacturers required to detail & make public how their vehicles identify motorcycles & include human error analysis in safety reports. Include & reports incidents between AV's & motorcycles. Transportation bill in Senate Public Works Committee. Bill is then passed to Senate Commerce Committee (which has power over NHTSA). This is where things like funding for motorcycle only check points will be considered. Timetable on this bill is always moving but MRF is prepared to be part of the discussion.
