

CAREER COLLEGE

- PRIVATE SCHOOL THAT OFFERS TRAINING IN SERVICE OCCUPATIONS.
 - MANY PROGRAMS TAKE LESS THAN A YEAR.
 - ARE FOR PROFIT SO TUITION IS SOMETIMES HIGH

EX: FLORIST, LPN, SECRETARY, TRAVEL AGENT

TECHNICAL SCHOOL



- TEACH HANDS ON SKILLS
- ARE PRIVATE
- PROVIDE TRAINING PROGRAMS FOR SPECIFIC OCCUPATIONS
- SOMETIMES KNOWN AS TRADE SCHOOLS OR TRADE COLLEGES

Ex: AUTO MECHANIC, CARPENTER, CHEF, ELECTRICAL INSTALLER, COMPUTER TECHNICIAN

VO-TECH CENTER

- OFFER TRAINING FOR HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AS WELL AS ADULTS
- ARE PUBLIC (NOT FOR PROFIT)
- IN HIGH SCHOOL THE TRAINING IS USUALLY FREE
- OVER 1400 VO-TECH SCHOOLS IN THE UNITED STATES

EX: SAME AS ABOVE (TECH SCHOOL)



COMMUNITY COLLEGE

- PUBLIC POSTSECONDARY SCHOOL THAT OFFERS TWO YEAR PROGRAMS (ASSOCIATES DEGREE) IN MANY SUBJECTS
- SOMETIMES REFERRED TO AS JUNIOR COLLEGES
- ARE NON-PROFIT



EX: AUTO MECHANIC, BOOKKEEPER, COURT REPORTER, DENTAL HYGIENIST, PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSISTANT, X-RAY TECHNICIAN

FOUR YEAR COLLEGE

- OFFER BACHELOR'S DEGREE
- COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY

EX: ACCOUNTANT, COMPUTER PROGRAMMER, JOURNALIST,
MARKETING MANAGER, SOCIAL WORKER
