

#### **LCAL** at the October Starline Factory

We want to encourage all of our members to consider entering the Oct 4th Friday event. This is usually the best event of the year and draws the largest crowd. The last live Oct 4th Friday event had an estimated 700-800 people come through, which makes this the best opportunity for sales.

October will be a big month for LCAL at the Starline Factory in Harvard. We will be represented in three different shows.

Here is a little about the different galleries at Starline. The regular Starline 4<sup>th</sup> Friday art show will be in the large, first floor gallery where there may be 40 or more individual artists that have entered this juried event. LCAL usually has at least two or more of our members represented in this show.

The second gallery is where we had our June show and is usually referred to as the Upstairs gallery (they're working on coming up with a formal name for it). LCAL will once again have this gallery for the artists that submitted work to show and we will be hanging the work later in October. This time we had Tom Trausch judge the entries and he selected 28 works (two from each of the 14 artists who submitted work) to include in the show.

The third gallery, and this is the exciting part, is the closed in gallery that shares the second floor space with the Upstairs gallery and is called the Overland Gallery. In the past, this gallery was exclusively used by resident artists, however, this space has now become available and Starline is using it to highlight four or five 2D artists each month along with one or two sculptors. These artists are not specific to any one art league and will be chosen by Starline and will have their work displayed for an entire month. If they like the way this works out, then they will continue this starting in January and, hopefully, we'll be able to get more of the LCAL artists in there.

The four artists that will participate in this first show are **Phil Schorn**, **Leslie Scott**, **Mary Norvell**, **and Jeff Harold** (below are samples of each artist's work). Starline hasn't provided us with the names of the sculptors yet but they have several already in mind for this show that have shown there before.

#### Joe Drapalik Offers Art Supplies

Member **Joe Drapalik** has continued the membership of his wife Betty after she died in 2007, and is now offering the last of her art materials for sale to other members for 15-20% of their value. These items are well known to many and needed by others, but we asked Joe for more details about his "10 display panels." It turns out that these are the same kind of panels used at the Undercroft Gallery, an open mesh design well suited for outside display under a canopy.

For example, Joe's ten panels, per <a href="http://www.graphicdisplaysystems.com/">http://www.graphicdisplaysystems.com/</a>, appear to be model XP37 and would today cost \$1300 plus shipping from Lebanon PA. The buyer would have to inspect the panels, determine their practical value, explain that to Joe Drapalik, and offer 15-20%. If the panels were to be used by a 501(c)(3) charitable organization he would charge nothing.
