IF YOU GET A FOLOW-UP CALL FROM CENSUS!!!

Census follow-up calls are underway. Follow-up calls ensure that everyone is counted, counted only once, and counted in the right place.

C Let your public know that if they get a call from **(844) 809-7717**, it is not a scam. It is the US Census with a question about some part of their self-response. If the person does not pick up, **they can call back** at that same number. They will attempt multiple calls.

For those concerned about spoofed calls, this is the safe way to handle.

When you call back, they ask for the 12-digit census ID which they include in the call back message. If the person does not have it we can look up the house using the phone number and address. No problem.

An example for checking would be confirming that a college-aged member of the family should not be counted at home, but instead be counted on their campus.
