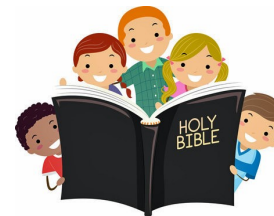


We welcome all who are here today.

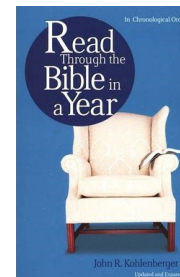
