MASS THEME

Theme: Faith and Fellowship
“Birds of a feather flock together.” With respect to certain instincts, we humans are no different from cows in a pasture flocking together when a thunderstorm is threatening . We need one another's company and inspiration to keep going. Marital love can survive only if the partners daily foster togetherness with all the means nature and religion suggest. The survival of faith is subject to the same conditions. A Christianity lived “alone”, all by oneself, does not last. The first reading describes the communal life of the early congregation in Jerusalem. “Koinonia” (fellowship, brotherhood, communion) should be an important element in the life of Christians of all ages. Faith, like love, is constantly exposed to the temptation of doubt and indifference. We need one another's support. You are blessed if you have/belong to a family where Christian fellowship is part of family life, where the members pray/worship together, read the bible together, practice the Christian values of love, justice, mutual respect, decency, and concern together. In such a case, the members of the family carry one another and that fellowship keeps faith alive.

Fellowship should also be part of every congregation though this poses a problem in a large parish. We need belonging! Parish councils should discuss available options. Participate in some activity of your parish. Do not be a loner! Without being exclusive, have friends who feel the same as you do in matters of faith. And at meetings, contribute to the value of “belonging” for all. Listen, be open to others, exchange ideas and experiences, share time and talents. “The brethren devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life” (First Reading). The above may suggest how to realize this in our time and culture

BIBLICAL COMMENTARY

First Reading
Acts 2:42-47 [True Christian Fellowship]
We learn from this reading that besides communal life the early Jerusalem church devoted itself to the teachings of the apostles (the Hebrew Bible and the way Jesus had interpreted it by word and example), the breaking of the bread, and the prayers (participating in the prayers of the Jewish temple). Sharing “all things in common” was done in the Jerusalem Church for at least some time. This is not a universal law for all Christians. The point for us is their fellowship , which we should all practice.

Second Reading
1 Pt 1:3-9 [Love in Practice]
This reading is taken from the First Letter of Peter which is probably a homily (sermon) given on the occasion of a baptismal ceremony. Notice how the homilist relates our rebirth through baptism to the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Christian rebirth from water and Spirit is a birth to hope-to an imperishable inheritance. It is all for you “who by the power of God are safeguarded through faith.” although you have never seen the Lord Jesus, you love him, and without seeing you believe in him.
A well known Baptist preacher of Harlem used to say: “Keep the faith, baby!” this is a folksy way of saying it. But the underlying concern must be ours, and it should be done in fellowship with others!
