## WEEKLY THOUGHTS 6<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY OF EASTER MAY 10<sup>th</sup> 2026

Dear friends, welcome to the celebration of the 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter and second Sunday in May of 2026. The Month of May is dedicated to Our Lady Mary and Mother of Jesus our Savior. Let us find time to pray the Rosary which St. John Paul II called a way through the Scriptures. Let Mary intercede for peace in the world and in the hearts of leaders of nations.

In the Gospel Reading of last Sunday; John 14: 1-12 Jesus exclaimed before his disciples, *"I am the way, the truth and the life."* Jesus is our sure way to the Father, and his way is full of suffering, sacrifice, death and grief. 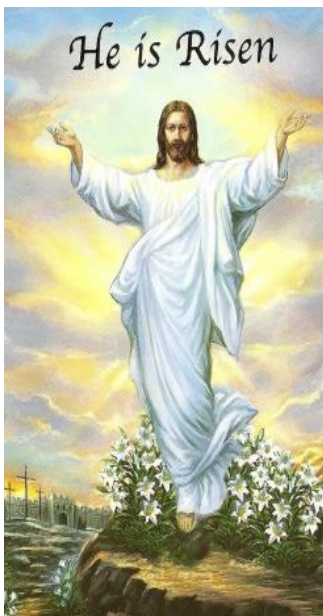
