Attention! A Note from Fr. Andrzej

We will soon begin Saint Olaf Faith Formation for children and adults (August 18). Please, make sure that all children, K-8, who do not go to Catholic Schools, participate in the Parish Program. It is required that these wishing to receive the Sacraments of First Communion or Confirmation participate in formation for at least two consecutive years. Children who have not been baptized and are older than 7 years need to be formed through OCIA Program for Children. *For more information or to sign up contact Carol at 801.295.3621*

Our adult formation for those who wish to learn about and join the Church also begins on Sunday, August 18 at 10:00 am in the Chapel Room. Please encourage those who might have expressed the desire to become Catholic to join the OCIA Program.
