1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:32 PM by Dwight Warren.

# 2. Review/ Approve meeting minutes

- Sand Pond Picnic Table: Selectmen discussed with Russ the need to dispose of a picnic table

  replace the one in poor condition.

- Selectmen reviewed and signed the revaluation contract for Cumberland County Assessing.
