-Leo McCauley was present to thank the board and let them know how much appreciated the Veterans banners are.

-Betty Glenn was in attendance to discuss hooking up to village water permanently. One option discussed was abandoning their well and running new water line to their house from the water line already running under Rt. 89 to their property. A remote meter will be installed in their home to meter water usage. Village responsibility is only to their buffalo box which is located in D. Richardson's yard. Our Village Attorney will be contacted to discuss this situation and make sure everyone involved is legally protected.

**ZONING AND PLANNING**

**MAINTENANCE**

-Haar presented options on bench seating for the gazebo. Cimei made a motion to purchase (4) 3' backless benches in the color dark gray from QW Amish/Minnesota. Cost for the benches is \$210 each plus \$199 flat freight fee. J. Campbell seconded this motion, motion carried.

-Wright Tree Service has been in the village trimming all trees that will potentially grow into the power lines. Two ash trees on Main Street in front of Fay Apartments have been trimmed but Haar ask them to be completely removed.

A couple of trees have also been removed at Coleman Park.

-Haar is planning on getting the caps cleaned at the WWTP in the next couple weeks. Haar will contact Mark Ahlers to find out how to proceed with this.

#### **WATER AND SEWER**

-P. Harrison inquired about setting up appointments with Gillan Construction and Massey Jet Vac to pump the tanks at the lift stations, WWTP, and clean the baskets at the WWTP. The board approved getting this work done.

-Harrison updated the board on 10<sup>th</sup> Street property water meter installation. Property owner states he will be demolishing the current home on the property and putting up a new home. He also informed Harrison his water had been shut off by an outside source which has been verified by B. Harrison. No remote meter will be installed until new construction is completed.

#### **ENGINEERING**

-Water tower inspection is scheduled for November 11 at 11:00 am.

-September report was presented to the board – 54 hrs.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

-Trick or Treat has been set for Friday, October 31 from 6 pm – 8 pm. Hot dogs, chips, water will be served in Centennial Park from 5:30-6:00 pm by the bank. Village will supply hot dogs/buns and the bank will supply water and chips.

There will be no parade this year.

-New printers have been purchased for Treasurer and Clerk.

-Five shut off letters were sent out to residents due to non-payment. Village received no payment from these residents since August.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

-2025 Tax Levy information was presented to the board. After discussion, Trone made a motion to announce the tax levy for 2025 to be \$41,060. Campbell, J. seconded, motion carried.

-J. Campbell made a motion to hire The Corner Garden to decorate the flower pots on Main Street again this year for Christmas, R. Campbell seconded. Motion carried. Cost is \$75/pot.

-J. Campbell will check into storing the produce box for winter.

-Haar stated a new RR sign is needed by the tracks. Harrison will check with county to see if that is our responsibility or theirs to replace.

-Haar was given the ok to purchase a 6" auger for poles from Rural King for approximately \$250.00.

-There have been reports of a couple dogs running at large in the village. Letters and copies of ordinances will be mailed to the owners.

There was no further business. Cimei made a motion to adjourn, Baker seconded, motion carried.

Meeting was adjourned.
