Program Modifications Due to COVID-19

ACTS goal is to make sure our clients and staff are protected from the Coronavirus. With this in mind, program modifications are necessary at this time starting March 23, 2020.

Outpatient

- As previously announced, all new clients must take our COVID-19 Screening before entering the ACTS building.
- Groups and individual sessions will now be conducted via telephone/video conferencing.
- IOP Groups are limited to 10 participants.
- IOP individual sessions will now take place via telephone/video conferencing.
- Urine screenings will continue as normal.

Housing/Firemen's Hall Drop-In Center Program Changes

- Client office visits and client transportation are suspended until further notice.
- The Drop-In Center Hours have been changed to Tuesday and Thursday from 10 a.m. - 2 p.m. for Doctor's Appointments.
- On those days, clients must complete the COVID-19 Screening before entering the program, and participants will be limited to 10 people.

Outpatient Detox

- All Outpatient Detox Groups have been suspended until further notice.
- OPD Clients will now be seen by individual sessions via telephone/video conferencing.
- For MAT participants who require minimal medication monitoring, take home medications will be supplied for 3 to 7 days.
- Urine screenings will continue as normal.

Treatment Program Modifications

This includes our Addictions Receiving Facilities, Residential Treatment Programs, ICP, ARRIS, ALF, VRSS and Drew Park.

- Programs are establishing a single point of entry for admissions.
- All visitation has been suspended.
- Client outings is only for medical appointments or jobs.
- No external group providers allowed.
- A curfew will be imposed for clients excluding medical appointments and employment.
