**O Street Traffic Enforcement Project**

In an effort to help reduce traffic accidents and promote motor vehicle safety, the Lincoln Police Department working in conjunction with the Nebraska State Patrol, will be conducting a traffic enforcement detail May 24<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The objective is to conduct a High Visibility Traffic Enforcement Detail within the city limits of Lincoln in an effort to help impact illegal driving behavior, promote safe and responsible driving and reducing motor vehicle accidents. This will be a joint project with emphasis on "O" Street between 17<sup>th</sup> and 84<sup>th</sup> Streets.

The **Nebraska Office of Highway Safety** is providing overtime funding for increased enforcement during this detail.

In addition to projects, Don't forget to remind each other and your loved ones to remember the 9pm Routine.
