Secretary's Report: Minutes from the January 2026 meeting was read by Mike Wyckoff. Motion was made and minutes were approved.

Treasurer's Report: Cal Roberts provided the February 2026 Treasurer's Report. Motion was made and Treasurer's Report was approved.

Membership Report: 9 Board of Directors, 14 Reduced Rate Members and 282 Social Members for a total of 305 out of the 350 limit. There are 40 Life Members, 1 Honorary and 2 Junior for an additional 43 with total of 348.

Dan Grey reported that Youth Archery is cancelled for February and will restart in March once the Indoor Range is finished.

County League Representative provided County League news:

- Hunter education classes are being provided at various clubs
- Trout season opens April 4, 2026
- Fishing Derby for children will be on May 2, 2026 at Hopewell Community Park
- Youth Camp at Raccoon Creek State Park will start on June 21, 2026. Daytime volunteers do not need background check. Nighttime volunteers will need a background check at no cost to them.
- Youth Field Day at Midland will be on July 18, 2026

Work Day items:

- For Indoor Range, block cold air coming into range at the target line.
- Build new target holders for Pistol Range #1.

Club Projects:

- Modification of Pistol Range #1 is progressing. Parking lot has been enlarged. Backstop on the range has been built. New target holders will need built. 100 and 200 yard Rifle Ranges are accessible.
- Drywall project for Indoor Range is about $\frac{3}{4}$ done. Once drywall is done, new LED lighting for the range and clubhouse will be installed. Some electrical wiring will need to be done. Estimated completion time is 2 weeks.
