### **Quick facts about domestic terrorism in the United States:**

1. An average of 11.4 incidents occurred annually, with an increasing trend from 2000 to 2013.
2. 160 incidents occurred between 2000 and 2013.
3. 20 incidents occurred in 2014 and 20 incidents in 2015.
4. Of the incidents between 2000-2013: 26 ended with law enforcement at the scene.
5. Of the incidents between 2000-2013: 6 ended when citizens acted to end the threat.
6. Of the incidents between 2000-2013: 40 occurred, resulting in 92 deaths
7. Of the incidents during 2016: 13 occurred; 71 deaths
