
# University of Alaska Southeast (UAS) Indigenizing Education for Alaska (IEA) Scholarships

## Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) Scholarship

- Description: Awards ten competitive \$5,000 scholarships to qualified Alaska Native and American Indian students pursuing health care careers.
- Application Period: Opens March 1st annually.

#### **American Indian College Fund Scholarships**

- Description: Offers merit-based scholarships to American Indian and Alaska Native students attending accredited nonprofit colleges or universities in the U.S.

  pioneer in Native media and advocate for the Yup'ik language
  and culture. This scholarship supports college students with ties
  to the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta, with preference given to those
  studying journalism, indigenous languages, multimedia, or
  communications.

## >>> Mary Ciuniq Pete Legacy Scholarship

- Description: Created to honor Mary Ciuniq Pete, a leader dedicated to education, environmental health, and the safety of women and girls in Western Alaska. This scholarship supports returning students (second year and beyond) at the University of Alaska Fairbanks-Kuskokwim Campus (KuC), with a preference for Alaska Native women.
