

Pentwater Sportfishing Association Bannink's End of Summer Lines Down Tournament 2019

The Pentwater Sportfishing Association (PSA) held the fifth annual "Bannink's End of Summer Lines Down" fishing tournament Saturday, August 31st. Twenty-eight boats participated and over 331 pounds of fish were caught. Prizes were awarded to the crew of Lineman (with Captain Rudy Gotlund) who secured the largest King Salmon weighing in at 25.20 pounds. The heaviest trout was a Steelhead weighing 8.0 pounds brought in by "Just Lookin" (crewed by Chris & Amy Sharp and family). The heaviest combination weight (of salmon and trout) was awarded to "After Five" (with Captain Tom Meyer) at 33.4 pounds. The crew from "Just The Beginning" (with Captain John Lammi) won closest mystery weight category with a 3.9-pound Coho. Cash prizes were awarded and all participants received consolation prizes. Captain Dave German of "Bad Habits" won a \$100 gift card donated by Jay's Sporting Goods as a special prize.
