Approved by the Westfield Board of Education, Kinderprep's Kindergarten offers a nurturing, full-day program from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., with flexible extended hours available from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Our schedule is designed to support working families and provide children with a safe, engaging environment throughout the day.

Our Curriculum

Created by our dedicated owners and directors, Lara Pallant and Jennifer Kelly, our curriculum is built around monthly themes that spark curiosity and creativity. Each academic subject is thoughtfully integrated into these themes, ensuring a holistic and meaningful learning experience.

- **Mathematics:** We use the Everyday Math curriculum, which emphasizes hands-on exploration and problem-solving. Children learn mathematical concepts through interactive activities that make learning both fun and meaningful.
- **Language Arts:** Our Fundations program offers a multisensory approach to reading, writing, phonics, and spelling. Students experience a variety of reading genres throughout the year, enjoy both guided and independent reading, and are encouraged to express themselves through writing and illustration. Creative writing activities help children develop their ability to communicate ideas through words and drawings.

- **Science:** Science lessons encourage students to make predictions, experiment, observe, and draw conclusions. Our hands-on approach includes opportunities for culinary creations, allowing children to explore scientific concepts in everyday life.
- **Social Studies:** We introduce children to different people, cultures, habitats, and the world we live in. Lessons foster an appreciation for diversity and help students understand their place in a global community.
- **Art:** Art is a time for self-expression and creativity. We believe the process is more important than the product, and we encourage each child's personality to shine through their artwork.

Play and Social Development

In addition to academics, children have ample time for free play and dramatic play. These activities are essential for socialization, imagination, and emotional growth. Outdoor play and exercise are also prioritized to promote a healthy lifestyle.

Small Class Size and Admissions

Our kindergarten class accommodates just eight students, ensuring personalized attention and a close-knit community. Enrollment is determined by a lottery among currently enrolled PreK students each October. If spots remain after the lottery, we welcome new students beginning November 2nd. A deposit and registration fee are required upon registration; please note that these fees are non-refundable once registered. Deposits are credited toward June's tuition.
