“HOW WELL DO YOU SEE?”

“Lord, I pray thee, open my eyes, that I may see.”

II Kings 6: 15-17. “Lord, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see.”

What do you do once you can “see”?

Confirmation: Spirit, Scripture, historically, others, situation.

John 20:29. “Jesus said, Blessed are they that have not seen, and yet have believed.”
Spirit- Scripture- other- conviction.

II Kings “Lord, I pray thee, open my eyes, that I may see.”

Pray and walk like a penguin. Or pray and take the leap.
