Hinckley Finlayson School Update: 60 students graduated last year and 5 of them will be taking advantage of the Kick Start program. 7 graduated from the alternative learning program. Football field is not going to be finished in time for the season to start. The first 2 football games will be moved to East Central and we are hoping the grass seed will take root in time for the last 2 games to be held at home. Early Childhood programing has been modified for all students to get 2 full days this year. There will be 10 new teachers in the district. The backpack program sends home meals with students for the weekend based on family needs/requests. You can round up to the nearest dollar at Daggetts and it funds the backpack program.
