#### HISTORIAN'S CORNER

#### PEACETIME MARINE CORPS ACTIONS

Many more of us have served in the Corps in peacetime than during times of conflict. The Marines have been called on many times to be involved in humanitarian operations and evacuations around the world. When the world needs the help of the USA, our country's reply is "Send in the Marines".

Here are a just a few examples

supplies.

June 1970, Peru 32d Marine Amphibious Unit (MAU) (Company A, Battalion Landing Team ½ and Marine Medium Helicopter Squadron 365) provided assistance to the victims of an earthquake in Peru by transporting medical teams to remote areas, transporting victims to medical facilities and delivering more than 55 tons of relief

October 1980, Algeria Marine helicopters provided assistance to victims of an earthquake in Al Asnam, Algeria.

*July 1990, Philippines* MAGTF-4-90 and 13<sup>th</sup> MEU assisted in search and rescue missions and emergency relief operations to victims of an earthquake. Marines conducted 313 sorties, lifted 627,000 pounds of cargo and flew more than 1,800 persons in Baguio City, Cabanatuan.

30 May – 2 June 1997, Freetown, Sierra Leone: 22<sup>nd</sup> MEU evacuated 451 American citizens and 2,058 foreign nationals.

2004 Port-Au-Prince, Haiti: Fifty Marines from a special detachment of the 4<sup>th</sup> Marine Expeditionary Brigade (MEB) landed in the Haitian capital of Port-Au-Prince to secure the US Embassy and help evacuate American citizens. Source; History division. USMC

The contributions of Vietnam Veterans from Detroit to their country and city are on display in a new exhibit at the museum through October 19. See Detroit Free Press, June 27, 2025, Scott Talley reporting.

The exhibit tells the story of the forming of and contributions of the Vietnam Veterans of America, Detroit Chapter Number 9.. Our own Mark and Irene Spooner spent countless hours organizing the exhibit as well as hosting the opening reception which took place on June 26.









Chapter 9 raised \$30K for a trained service dog for a veteran. The Chapter was entitled to name the dog, and they did, meet Motown.
