Jeremiah Rescued from the Cistern
Jeremiah 38:7-13 (ESV)

Leader:

When Ebed-melech (e-bid-mel-lik) the Ethiopian, a eunuch who was in the king's house, heard that they had put Jeremiah into the cistern

Congregation:

—the king was sitting in the Benjamin Gate— Ebed-melech (e-bid-mel-lik) went from the king's house and said to the king,

Leader:

"My lord the king, these men have done evil in all that they did to Jeremiah the prophet by casting him into the cistern,

Congregation:

and he will die there of hunger, for there is no bread left in the city."

Leader:

Then the king commanded Ebed-melech (e-bid-mel-lik) the Ethiopian,

Congregation:

"Take thirty men with you from here, and lift Jeremiah the prophet out of the cistern before he dies."

Leader:

So Ebed-melech (e-bid-mel-lik) took the men with him and went to the house of the king, to a wardrobe in the storehouse,

Congregation:

and took from there old rags and worn-out clothes, which he let down to Jeremiah in the cistern by ropes.

Leader:

Then Ebed-melech (e-bid-mel-lik) the Ethiopian said to Jeremiah, "Put the rags and clothes between your armpits and the ropes." Jeremiah did so.

ALL:

Then they drew Jeremiah up with ropes and lifted him out of the cistern. And Jeremiah remained in the court of the guard.
