CONDITIONS OF RELEASE

All conditions below must be followed by every defendant released from district, municipal, county or federal custody using a bail bond or corporate surety bond placed by a bail agent of 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds or placed by another bail agent on behalf of 1st Out 24/7 Bail

1. The defendant is required to attend any and all court proceedings related to the bail bond posted.
2. When the defendant is released from any jail or correctional facility, he or she is required to report to 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds within 24 hours of release for a photograph.
3. If the defendant misses a court appearance, you must notify 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds and our agents will assist you. Failure to contact your bail agent will result in the defendant being considered a fugitive and the file will be assigned to a Fugitive Recovery Agent. Bail will be revoked at this time.
4. The defendant is required to CHECK-IN once per week in person. If it is physically impossible to CHECK-IN in person then the defendant may call 484-951-5975 to CHECK-IN by telephone once per week.
5. The defendant is required to notify 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds of all new court appearance dates. All superior court date notification must be done in person. The defendant is required to submit a copy of court date notices to 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds.
6. The defendant and indemnitor(s) are required to notify 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds of any and all changes in address and telephone.
7. The defendant is required to notify 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds of his or her current attorney.
8. All defendants or their indemnitor(s) must immediately notify 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds if the defendant is re-incarcerated for any reason.
9. The Defendant and indemnitor(s) are required to pay any outstanding premium balances in accordance with the terms established in the promissory note. If the defendant and/or indemnitor(s) fails to comply with any payment plan, the defendant can be re-incarcerated for failure to comply with payment. Additionally, 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds shall institute a civil action against any and/all indemnitor(s) listed on the bail in order to seek full payment on the bond.
10. Failure to comply with any above conditions of release shall be grounds to revoke the bail bond posted, re-arrest the defendant and surrender the defendant to proper authorities. Furthermore, in the event of your re-arrest or surrender by 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds or any other authority, the defendant and all indemnitors shall individually be responsible for any fees or costs arising from such an arrest.
11. Collateral cannot be returned to the defendant or the indemnitor(s) until the appropriate court provides written proof of discharge or exoneration of all of the bail bonds posted. All premium fees collected for the bond are non-refundable.
12. The defendant is not permitted to leave the state of incarceration, except for residing in another state or for any reason that is approved by your bail agent.
13. Should the defendant fail to check-in with their bail agent on a regular basis, he/she will be subject to random visits at home or work by an agent of 1st Out 24/7 Bail Bonds. Furthermore, the defendant does face bail revocation and can be re-incarcerated for non-compliance of the above-referenced conditions.
