

MILDRED M. McINTYRE

1905 - 1992

Mildred M. McIntyre, age 87 of Pigeon, passed away Wednesday, September 9 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon, following a long illness.

She was born in Fort Wayne Indiana on July 6, 1905, the daughter of the late Charles and Bessie (Willeman) Davies. On August 17, 1929 she was united in marriage to Warren R. McIntyre in Bay Port. He preceded her in death on June 22, 1952.

Mrs. McIntyre graduated from Arthur Hill High School in Saginaw and Central Normal College, Mt. Pleasant. She taught elementary school in both Bay Port and Pigeon, and retired after 43 years as an insurance agent with the W.R. McIntyre Insurance Agency, Pigeon. She was a member of the Pigeon Worthwhile Club, the Pigeon Historical Society, the First United Methodist Church of Pigeon, and the United Methodist Women.

Surviving are her daughter and son-in-law, Margaret and James Hartman, Pigeon; two grandchildren, Stacie Lynn Hartman, Southfield and Michael (Michelle) Hartman, Westland; a great-granddaughter, Olivia Lynn; two brothers, Richard (Faith) Davies, Melvin and Jack (Clara) Davies, Livonia; and several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by four brothers and a sister.
