

# HAROLD GREGOR

## 1902 - 1996

Harold E. Gregor, 94, lifelong resident of Oliver Township, died Tuesday morning, Dec. 12 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon.

He was born Sept. 25, 1902 to the late George and Isabelle (Schuart) Gregor in Oliver Township.

On April 16, 1927, he was united in marriage to Beatrice M. Foster at her parents' home in Winsor Township. She preceded him in death March 4, 1990.

Mr. Gregor was employed at People's Oil & Gas Co., Elkton, for two years, and at E. Paul and Son Hardware and Implement Business Pigeon, for two years. He farmed most of his life, first farming with his father until 1949, then on his own until retiring in 1980.

He was a member of Elkton United Methodist Church, the Elkton Senior Citizens, and Farm Bureau.

Surviving are one son, Kenneth (Iva) Gregor of Elkton; two grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by one brother, Charles Gregor, and one sister, Iva King.

Funeral services were held Dec. 12 at Champagne Funeral Chapel., Elkton, with Rev. Peter Crawford, pastor of Elkton United Methodist Church officiating. Burial is in Grandlawn Cemetery, Pigeon.
