
Lot's to do, lots to see and lots to buy and lots to eat. Fortunately we were redirected to the best peameal sandwich vendor.

Brian Baker didn't win the 50-50 pot 'cause they wouldn't let him draw the ticket...


We all left around 3:30 except for Norby who still may be there.




## TICKETS NOW ON SALE FOR CTMP'S 2025 MAJOR EVENTS


