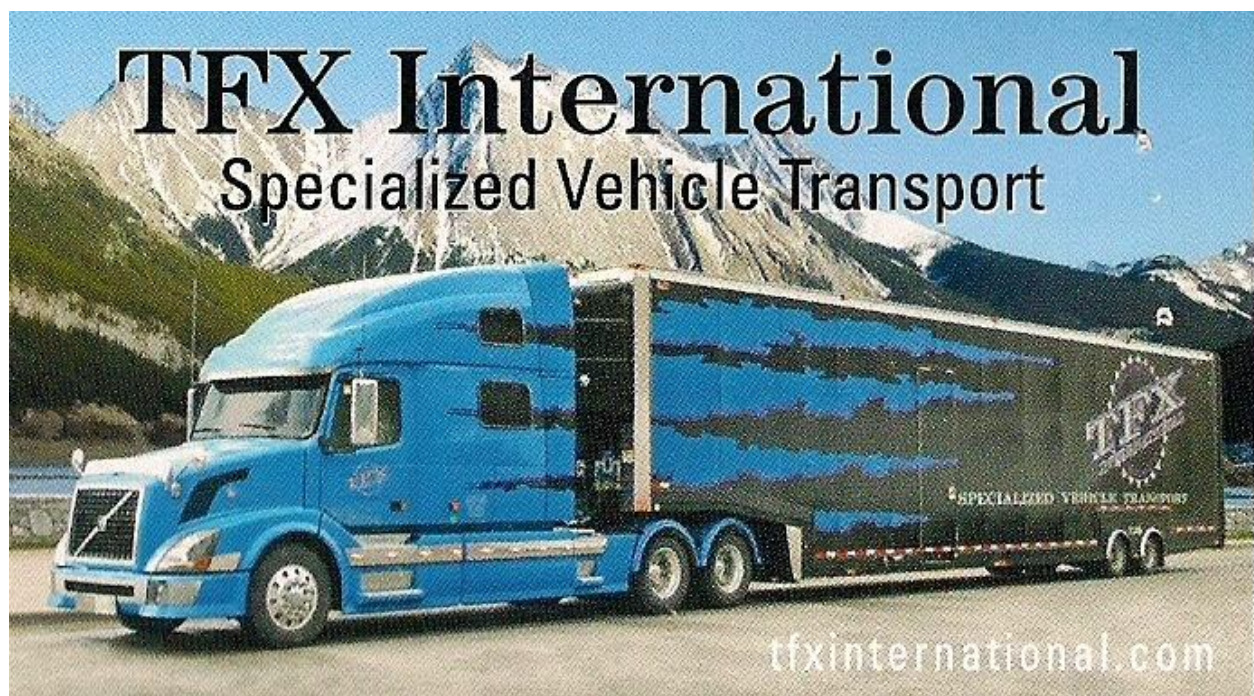

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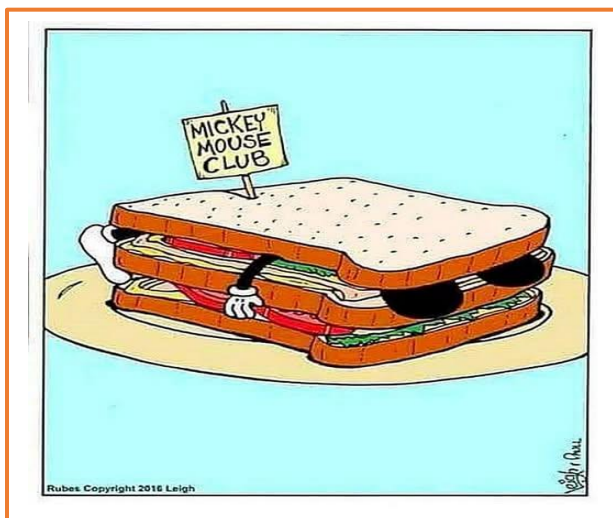
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COD Newsworthy News

- ✚ A huge thank you to John Heinrichs for arranging the cruises this year.





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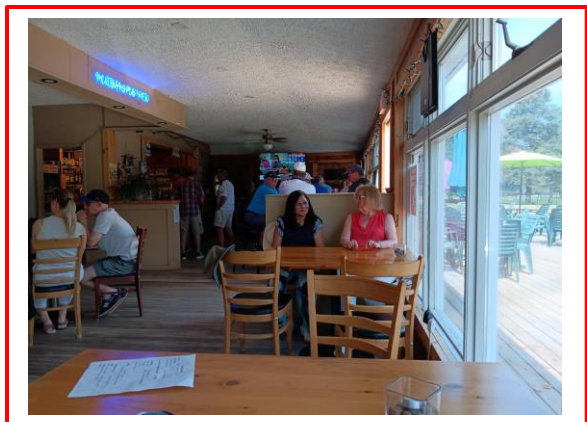

Thanks to John H for arranging this cruise.



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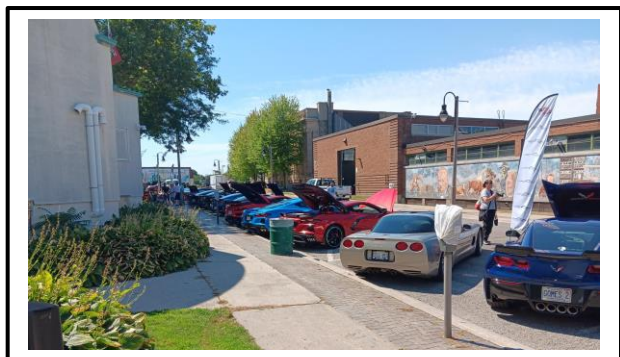
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KARS ON KING

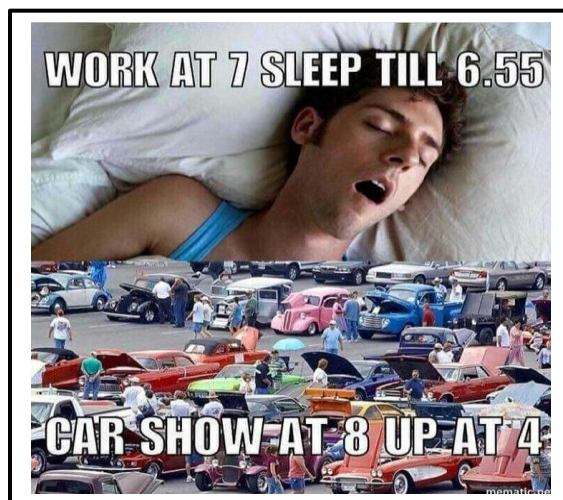


Lot's to do, lots to see and lots to buy and lots to eat. Fortunately we were redirected to the best peameal sandwich vendor.

Just a note, John H left before me...that's a first.



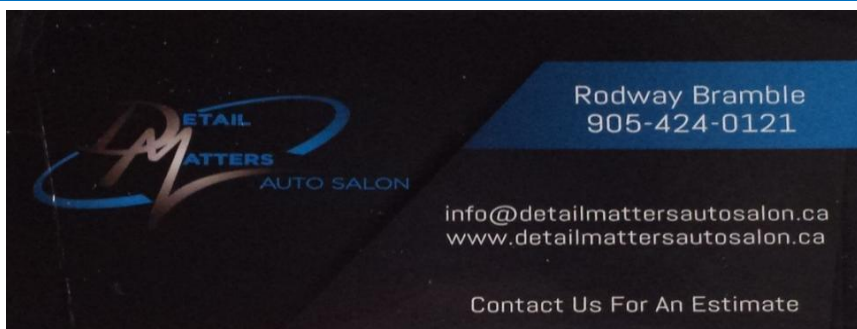


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TICKETS NOW ON SALE FOR CTMP'S 2025 MAJOR EVENTS
