Wednesday Night Bus Procedures



- I. Students must be at least 5yrs of age to ride.
- II. There will be two adults on each church vehicle.
- III. If a driver or rider is not available, that team is responsible for getting a substitute. The adult rider is asked to sit in the back of the bus to assure clear vision and supervision of all students.



- IV. Students must stay seated in the vehicle at all times, use seat belts if available and use voices that allow them to hear any instructions given by the adults in charge.
- V. Students riding a church vehicle must have a completed and signed permission form in order to ride.



- VI. If a student is not riding the bus on a particular evening, a parent or the student him or herself is asked to call the office by 4:30 to let the bus driver know. (402-721-1265)



- VII. If the bus or van travels to pick up a student and the student is not there for two weeks in a row without notifying the church, a parent or guardian must call the church to reinstate pick up. (402-721-1265)



- VIII. Students will be given additional bus riding permission forms to take home so that if they bring a friend or friends to Wednesday night activities, the visitors can have a form filled out to present to the driver. This form is also available on the church website: www.fremontfbc.org.



- IX. If a particular bus or van is full and there are no remaining safe seats, the driver will call the church to arrange pickup with the big bus.
- X. We are happy to provide transportation for students who have no other way to get to the church and want them to be able to attend our Wednesday night events but due to growing numbers, we have a limited number of seats available on our vehicles. If parents are able to bring their children to the church at 6:30, it would be greatly appreciated. Pick up is at 8:00.

Wednesday Night Dinner Procedures



- I. When kids come in, they are to get their food and then go a table and sit down. There should, realistically, be one adult sitting at each table. That adult is responsible for making sure students stay seated.
- II. Students are not to roam around the room or from table to table.
- III. There are no limits on the amount of drink or food students will be given unless there is not enough for additional helpings.
- IV. Students do not have to clean their plates to get something else on the menu. For example, if a student doesn't eat all of their entree, they can still have an additional piece of bread or a cookie if extras are available. We don't all like the same things.
- V. Adults should be careful that comments made to students are positive and affirming. Correction should not be sharp or degrading in any way. If there is an issue with a student or parent, please let those in charge know immediately.
- VI. Students are to pick up their own dishes and place all trash in the trash can.
- VII. Adult helpers should control behavior in the line as students make their way upstairs.
- VIII. If you are scheduled to supply a meal and find that you cannot do it, please call the office immediately.

Kids' Klub and Youth Group are outreaches to the community which have grown extensively this year. It's important for all of us to remember that kids go home and talk to their parents about what happens here. We want to show the love of Christ but because we are dealing with children, we must have consistent procedures that are followed by all of us. Thanks so much for your commitment to this program.
