Regular Meeting ----- May 17, 1988

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman, D. L. Taylor at 7:00 A.M. Other Grand County Water Conservancy District members present were Gary Wilson, John "Dutch" Zimmerman and John Groo.

ATTENDANCE

Grand County Special Service District members present were D. L. Taylor, Gary Wilson, William D. McDougald, George White and Dan Holyoak.

Others present were Ray Klepzig, Tony Lema, Neldon Lemon, Dale Pierson and Roberta Highland.

Roberta read the minutes of the meeting of May 3, 1988. After calling for additions or corrections, and hearing none, the minutes were approved as read.

MINUTES

Dale reported that since our last meeting, Paul Rattle invited Dee Hansen, Larry Anderson, Susan Atwood Mark Page and some local residents to a meeting and tour of high ground water areas. At that meeting the Utah Geological & Mineral Survey Report was released, and arrived at the office Friday. His last memo to the Board was discussed, Pierson reported he had heard from Larry Anderson and Anderson recommended the District stand behind the report, because for the moment it is the best information we have. Anderson is planning on sending down an engineer to advise property owners and aid in some planning to alleviate their problems. The County Commission has informed him they will be requesting the District to sponsor a grant to help the affected property owners solve their groundwater problems.

HIGH GROUND
WATER PROBLEMS

Pierson asked for a policy definition for basic irrigation line repairs during the planting stage of the new nine holes at the golf course, since the district has been an agricultural operation, and repairs could usually wait until morning, overtime help has not been used on irrigation line problems. Overtime costs from Moab City is time and a half per man and equipment charges remain the same. Dave Cozzens has stated his costs would be about \$6.00 more per hour so he would be the cheaper to call for night work. Lema stated he would like the Board to back up Pierson in getting the lines in service as quickly as possible, at least in the early planting stage. Also he would like to be informed as quickly as possible when the line is down. Klepzig asked Pierson to get with McPhilomey about the pressures up there. Gary moved the District follow a policy of using any necessary overtime to keep the system up as long as the golf course is seeding. Dan seconded. MOTION CARRIED.


The financial statement and 1988 Irrigation water FINANCIAL sales report was handed to those present, and briefly discussed. STATEMENT
