

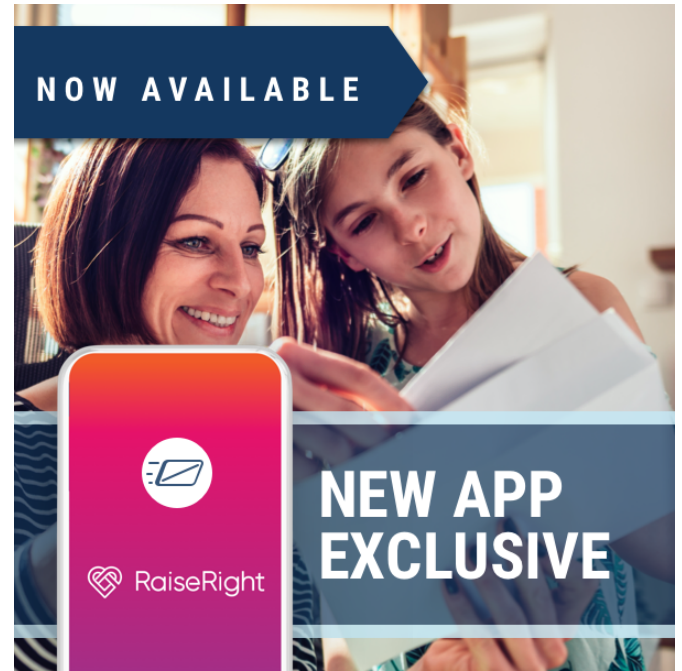
# GAGC NEWS

- The next program year begins immediately on June 1, 2021 and will run through May 31, 2022 with any tuition credit earned going toward the 2022/2023 school year.

# GAGC Q&A

Q. How is my Tuition Credit calculated?

A. The GAGC Program is primarily an HGA Parish Fundraiser, which began in 2001. In 2002, HGA's Pastor agreed to split the profit from the program between the parish and any school family to help offset the cost of tuition.

Currently, the break down of tuition credit earned is as follows:

- 1% to the GAGC Program for the cost of running the program
- the remaining rebate is split 50/50 between the Parish and the Family

However, once a family's tuition account amount reaches \$150, the rebate is no longer split between the parish and the family. The family will begin to receive the total rebate (minus the 1% program cost.) So, the goal is to earn \$150 in tuition credit as early on in the Program Year as you can so you can begin receiving 99% of the rebate from your purchases through the end of the program year.

Please note: There is a feature on the Shop with Scrip App that will show your rebate amount. Please keep in mind that the Raise Right App does not include any earnings from the purchase of our In-Stock gift cards (Giant, Redners, Weis, Sheetz, and Walmart). Neither does it reflect the 50/50 split of the rebates earned. Your Tuition Credit Statement issued in October, February, and June reflects the correct amount. You may contact the GAGC program at any time to find out what your YTD earnings are.

The Last Special Order for this Program Year is: Sunday, May 23rd by 1:00 pm with pick-up May 29 & 30.

The First Special Order Dates of the New Program Year will be: Sunday, June 6th by 1:00 pm with pick-up June 12 & 13 and Sunday, June 20th by 1:00 pm with pick-up June 26th & 27th.

Special Order gift cards may be picked up after each weekend Mass or at the Rectory on Tuesdays, Wednesday, and Thursdays from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.
