## Information

- The first level would be simply an information membership class. All the revived churches included this level as they instituted membership classes for their churches.
- Every class included the beliefs or doctrine of the church. Most of the classes introduced some or all of the church staff. If the church was a part of a denomination, it would not be uncommon to share some facts about the denomination. A significant percentage of the church leaders were emphatic that the information included some expression of vision for the church.
- ...Communicating the vision in the new member class was vital to the health of the church. It was second to doctrine in importance.
