#### **Testimonials**

My name is Jessica Krick, I am 22 years old. I started drinking alcohol and smoking marijuana at age 14 and had minor legal consequences as a direct result of my using. My short stay in the juvenile detention home and court ordered counseling and house arrest only stopped me until I was "in the clear" once again. A few years pass with no trouble. I am now 17 years old and have dabbled in pills and psychedelics. I had a devastating break up and quickly sought out someone else to fill my void and give my life purpose. That is when I met the man that introduced me to opiates and we used together for almost 2 years. I quit my job at subway, dropped out of college and became an exotic dancer right after my 18th birthday. Shortly after I started my dancing career my boyfriend had gotten a drug that I had never done before. I tried crack cocaine for the first time and I immediately lost interest in doing any-thing else. I stopped dancing and spent any money I had on my new drug of no choice. I broke up with that guy, so I did not have to share my precious supply with him anymore.

I was 18 surrounding myself with people three times my age just to get a fix. I lost my car and my home. I started prostituting to support my habit and couch surfing. I ran into legal consequences at 19 and was sentenced to my first treatment center. I was sober in rehab for 6 months and was the high the first day I got home and lasted until I was arrested for soliciting and sentenced to 2 months in jail. I got released and again was high the next day. The insanity of my addiction continued until I was 21.

On February 16, 2019 I was given another chance at sobriety. I was sitting in jail and wanted better for my life. I knew the life I was living was not the life that God had intended me to live. God put someone in my path that mentioned a new sober living that had just opened in my town. I then asked the judge for treatment in lieu of conviction and was granted my wish.

I arrived at Road to Hope Becky's House in Sandusky nervous and determined. Becky's house put rules and structure into my life that I needed so desperately. I started working the 12 steps with my sponsor and going to 5+ meetings a week. I got myself my first real job in over 4 years. I went to OVI school, got my license back and my mom let me drive her car. Things were falling into place and the promises were coming true. Unfortunately, I became complacent, greedy, insecure, and lonely. I was sober but started reverting to old behaviors, ways, people, and places. I wanted more money and attention. Anything I could use to fill the void. I lacked love for myself and I inevitably went back out because of my poor choices.

I used for two months and within the first 2 weeks I moved out of my sponsors house into my grandparents, totaled my grandfather's car, racked up 5K in restitution, overdosed twice, went to the psych ward, and had three warrants. I went to jail 7-12-2019 and the fog was lifted. I looked in the mirror 100lbs covered in scabs from picking at my skin. I begged for treatment again. I went to rehab for two months and had a sober ex-boyfriend get me into rehab and I got pregnant on the way. I could not keep up with paying my rent maintaining my sobriety, going to meetings and being 6 weeks pregnant.

I called Aubrey the director at Road to Hope and told her my situation. She told me I could come to Genesis by the lake in Vermilion the next day. I have been beyond blessed to have been given another chance to be at a RTH sober living house. The rules and requirements at Genesis have given me a stable foundation to rebuild my life upon. Today I am a loving present mother, sister, daughter, niece, and friend. I am 1 year and 6 months sober, actively working with my sponsor, sponsoring, doing service work, being a full-time mom, and working two jobs. I also went back to school and am a state tested nursing assistant. I got my license back; a car and I can afford to pay my rent at the Genesis honors condo.
