FACILITIES USE POLICY

Concerning Usage of Contest Performance Facilities Prior to a UIL Music Contest

The Executive Committee's intent with this policy is to **ensure and maintain equity for all competing organizations**. Also, to ensure that no organization or school should be given any opportunity that could create an advantage over any other competing organizations.

This policy states that:

“No school or competing organization is permitted to secure, or in any way use any performance facility (auditorium or stadium) for any rehearsal or performance at any time within a minimum time period of 30 days prior to the first day of their UIL contest at that facility.”

Exceptions:

- The school to which that performance facility serves as their “home auditorium or stadium”, or
- If an organization is competing in a competition hosted by the “home school” (i.e., football game).
 - If the “home school” hosts a pre-UIL contest in that facility, the competition must be well publicized and made available to EVERY competing organization that will be attending that particular competition. Attendance must be open, and may not be limited to any particular organizations or group of participants.
