SDCWGA TEAM PLAY 2021

The 2021 SDCWGA Team Play season wrapped up on July 1st with the completion of Regional playoffs at The Vineyard Golf Club in Escondido. 13 teams from 12 clubs participated in the 2021 season. For the regular season, teams were divided into three regions (North, Central and South), and faced each other home and away within each Region. Matches contested both Gross and Net points, with Regional winners advancing to playoffs in Gross and Net format.

Regional Winners - Gross

North: Encinitas Ranch North: Temecula Creek
Central: Coronado 1 Central: Admiral Baker
South: Steele Canyon South: Balboa Park

The playoffs were held as a round-robin playoff format where each of the Regional winners faced each other once. Total points earned across each team's two matches determined the winners.

The final competition was close, with only 2 points separating the three Regional winning teams in Gross, and 3.5 points separating the three Regional winning teams in Net. With strong performances in their final matches, Coronado and Balboa both stormed back from behind to win their respective championships.

RULES CORNER July 2021




Some new rules for BUNKER play:

- 1. If you decide a ball in a bunker is <u>unplayable</u> you now have the option to take BACK-ON-THE LINE relief by coming BEHIND the bunker, no closer to the hole, dropping a ball on a reference line going straight baack from the hole through the original spot of the ball and taking TWO penalty strokes. (Rule 19.3 See Diagram below for all bunker relief options)
- 2. Walls and lips consisting of soil, grass, or artificial material are NOT part of the bunker. (Rule 12.1)
- 3. There are relaxed restrictions (no penalty) on touching the sand when ball is in a bunker when: (Rule 12.2)
 - a) leaning on a club to rest, balance or prevent a fall
 - b) smoothing a bunker to care for the course
 - c) placing clubs or equipment in the bunker
- 4. Loose impediments and movable obstructions may be removed WITHOUT penalty. (Rule 12.2)

DIAGRAM 19.3: RELIEF OPTIONS FOR BALL UNPLAYABLE IN BUNKER

A player decides that his or her ball in a bunker is unplayable. The player has four options:

- (1) For **ONE** penalty stroke, the player may take stroke-and-distance relief
- (2) For **ONE** penalty stroke, the player may take back-on-the-line relief in the bunker
- (3) For **ONE** penalty stroke, the player may take lateral relief in the bunker
- (4) For a total of **TWO** penalty strokes, the player may take back-on-the-line relief outside the bunker based on a reference line going straight back from the hole through the spot of the original ball
