

MAIL or DROP OFF - OFFICIAL AKC entry form or photo copy including the agreement and instructions. with the required entry fee, Please type or neatly print.

A recording fee of 50 cents per first entry of each dog and Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry is required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only Ch. 11, Section 2, AKC Dog Show Rules.

- -The club assumes no responsibility for a wrong entry.
- -Entries without fees cannot be accepted. Entries specifying any condition as to acceptance cannot be accepted. Unsigned, incomplete, telephone, fax or email entries will not be accepted.
- -The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- -Entries will receive an email confirmation within 7 days after receipt, if an email address is provided on the entry form, otherwise, the confirmation will be sent via USPS standard mail. If acknowledgments are not received by an exhibitor 7 days prior to the Trial, please notify the Trial Secretary.
- -Consult Judging Schedule for time of judging.
- -Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
- -The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.
- -The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss or injury.
- -Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
- In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize.
- -Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, or other acts beyond the control of the Club, or if it is impossible to open or to complete the Trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. MOVE-UPS (Class Transfers) will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Please notify the Trial Secretary in writing as soon as possible, but at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the days judging.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the first class, then the Club will refund the entry fee, less a \$10 processing fee.

Rules for entering this trial:

- 1. NO overnight & NO day of show RV parking.
- 2. NO smoking allowed on the grounds.
- 3. You will not be allowed to leave your vehicle idling in the parking area.
- **4.** When entering the building you will enter and exit through the side door.
- **5.** Collars must be in accordance with AKC Board Policy, July 2001 (No Electronic Collars)
- 6. There shall be no drilling, intensive or corrective training of dogs on Trial premises
- **7.** Crating: Outdoors on grass. NO Stakes allowed. Wire/metal crates are encouraged for safety and ventilation. Mesh crate must be completely zipped closed while dog is inside.
- **8.** Dogs that escape from crate or are uncontrolled must be removed from the show site.
- 9. Please keep dogs quiet, if barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave.
- 10. Keep dogs on leash while not exhibiting.
- 11. EXHIBITORS RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEIR DOGS.

Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.
